## **Prior to Test Day**

- 1. Make sure your personal device has an internet connection and is fully charged.
- 2. Disable pop-up blocking on your internet browser (see supporting document).
- 3. Make sure your device meets testing requirements using the Device Readiness Tool.
- 4. Watch the MAP Growth introduction video.
- 5. Practice the test at practice.mapnwea.org.

## On Test Day

- 1. Minimize distractions for yourself or your students as much as possible.
- 2. Provide a quiet testing environment.
- 3. Log into your personal device.
- 4. Go to <u>www.dekalbschoolsga.org</u>, locate Clever and log in with your student credentials.
- 5. Connect to Microsoft Teams through teacher invitation.
- 6. Make sure you or your student has joined the Teams meeting with the examiner/proctor.
- **7.** Follow any additional instructions from the examiner/proctor.

The assessment will have audio in the following cases:

- All students in Kindergarten Grade 2
- Students in Grades 3 12 who receive Text-to-Speech accommodations as documented in their IEP, 504, or EL-TPC plans
