Network Systems Administration Degree Program

Today nothing is more critical to successful business operations than effective networks. Earn your associate degree in Network Systems Administration (NSA) from DeVry University and become a valuable asset to any company worldwide. Use the tools and techniques embraced by leaders, such as Cisco Systems, as you learn how to maintain existing network systems and launch new ones.

Nearly every industry demands these types of professionals who can activate accounts and security controls, install and configure routers and switchers, monitor network performance, and troubleshoot problems. The information below provides an overview of DeVry University's undergraduate admission requirements for earning a degree both online and on campus.

Interested Participants Must:

- Attend a Parent/Student Information Session with parent or guardian
- Complete the Advantage Academy application form
- Provide a letter of recommendation from a principal, counselor or teacher
- Submit a one-page letter of interest and/or essay
- Meet DeVry University standard admissions requirements
- Submit a high school transcript including grades from first semester of sophomore year

Basic and Pre-requisite Skills Evaluation

Applicants for an education online or on campus must show evidence of basic and prerequisite skills proficiency levels in at least one of the following; ACT or SAT examination scores deemed appropriate by DeVry. Although requirements may vary by program, the minimum scores DeVry considers when evaluating basic skills proficiency are:

- ACT Math 17; ACT English 17; SAT Math 460; SAT Verbal/Critical Reading 460.
- Applicants with lower scores in one or both areas may still demonstrate skills proficiency in any of the other ways listed.
 - Attain appropriate scores on DeVry administered placement examinations in reading, writing, arithmetic and algebra.
 - Submit required documentation indicating acceptable grades in qualifying work completed at a recognized institution.

Network Systems Administration

<u>Purpose</u> - The intent of this application is to make clear the student's academic requirements and to outline the educational services available in the Advantage Academy program.

<u>Tuition/Fees</u> - Tuition and fees for DeVry Advantage Academy students will be waived and textbooks will be provided. Students will be responsible for incidentals and assessed the cost of unreturned textbooks. Students that fail a DeVry course are responsible for tuition payment of repeated courses.

<u>Professional Educators</u> - High school courses are taught by board-certified DeKalb County School District teachers. College courses are taught by industry-experienced DeVry University professors.

General Information

The Advantage Academy program is a concurrent/dual enrollment opportunity for a student to complete both their high school education and earn a DeVry University associate degree simultaneously during their junior and senior year of high school. Students enter the program as a cohort with other students from their high school district. The academic calendar of the DeVry University courses may differ from the high school district calendar and includes a summer term. If a student fails or withdraws from a course, they will be given the opportunity to retake the course once at their own expense and remain within the cohort. The Advantage Academy program terminates when the student completes high school.

DeVry reserves the right to discontinue the instruction of a student whose conduct is in its judgment unsatisfactory. Students who commit a breach of school rules or normal standards of good conduct will be dismissed. DeVry may alter the number of credit or contact hours for reasons including, but not limited to, the following: natural occurrences beyond DeVry's control, holidays, special institutional activity days and registration days.

Additional Information

DeVry will provide Advantage Academy students with benefits such as use of library and lab facilities, tutoring, mentoring, use of career development resources, and membership in various student clubs and organizations. Advantage Academy students are not eligible for housing assistance, part-time employment assistance, Veterans Administration benefits or financial aid.

Admissions Requirements

Students will not be enrolled in the Advantage Academy program until all enrollment requirements are met. To be admitted to this program, students must meet the following requirements, including but not limited to: successful completion of 10th grade; a cumulative high school GPA of 2.5 or higher; a 90% attendance rate; good discipline record; and receive acceptable scores on DeVry University placement tests. Acceptance to this program is not guaranteed and DeVry may limit the number if qualified applicants exceed available spaces for the program; students will be selected through a selection committee of high school and DeVry University staff.

Application Requirements

- Completed, signed and dated Advantage Academy application and release of records statement.
- Letter of recommendation from a principal, counselor or teacher
- Letter of interest and/or essay
- Current high school transcript showing a cumulative high school GPA of 2.50 or higher
- Current high school records showing a minimum attendance record of 90% and good discipline record prior to admission to the DeVry University Advantage Academy

Continuous Enrollment Requirements

For successful participation and matriculation in the DeVry Advantage Academy, students are expected to: maintain 100% class attendance daily; complete all assigned coursework and other requirements on time; adhere to the rules/regulations and policies of Board of Education of DeKalb County School System (BOARD), DeVry Advantage Academy and DeVry University (including the BOARD and DeVry Codes of Conduct); maintain a GPA of 3.0; and return all course materials, books and supplies upon the conclusion of each term.

Student Consent for Continuing Release of Records

Under Federal legislation, including the Family Educational Rights and Privacy Act of 1974, I understand that my educational records cannot be released without my written permission or, in the case of a minor, the written permission of my parent or guardian.
