

## NOTICE OF PROPERTY TAX INCREASE

The DeKalb County School District has tentatively adopted a millage rate which will require an increase in property taxes by 5.06 percent.

This tentative increase will result in a millage rate of 23.38 mills, an increase of 1.127 mills. Without this tentative tax increase, the millage rate will be no more than 22.253 mills. The proposed tax increase for a home with a fair market value of \$225,000 is approximately \$87.34 and the proposed tax increase for non-homestead property with a fair market value of \$325,000 is approximately \$146.51.
