

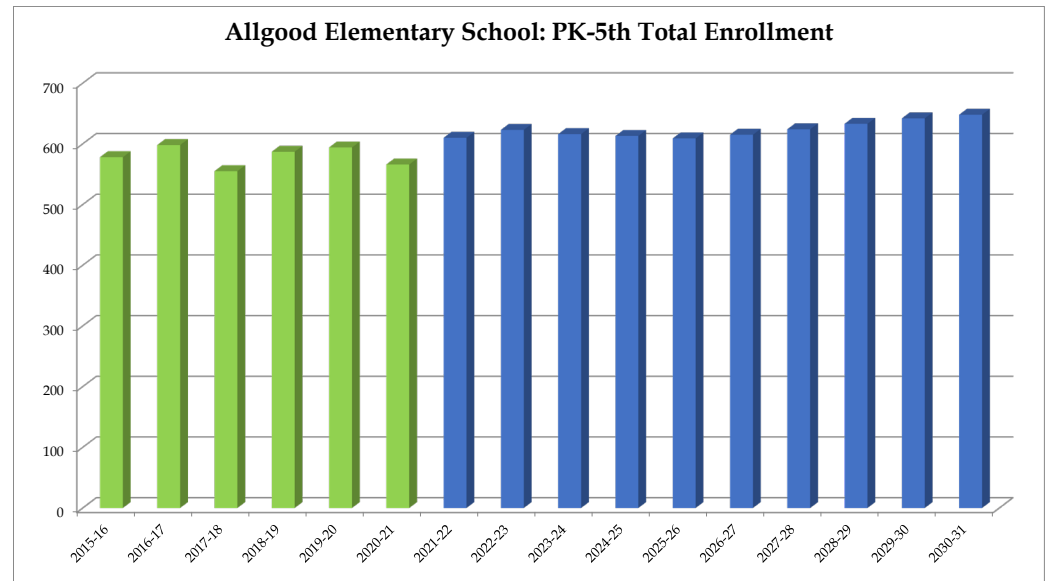

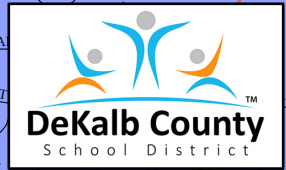
- Total enrollment is forecasted to increase by 43 students, or 7.6%, between 2020-21 and 2025-26.
  - Enrollment is forecasted to then increase by 39 students or 6.4%, between 2025-26 and 2030-31.
- **In total, enrollment is forecasted to increase by 82 students, or 14.5%, between 2020-21 and 2030-31.**

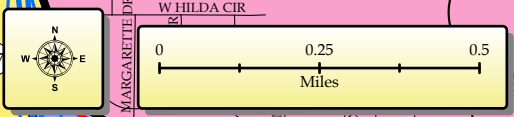
