

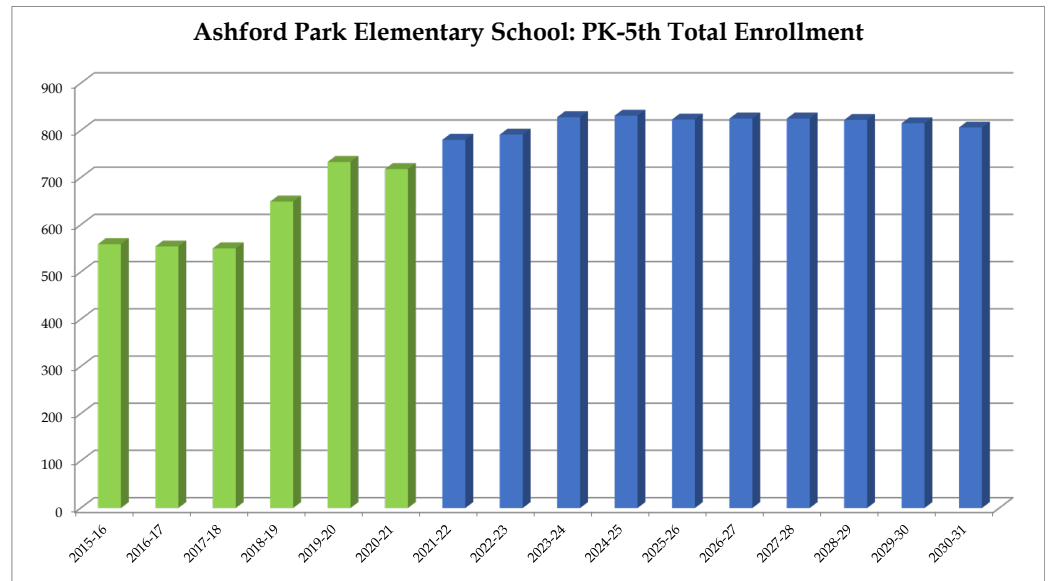

- Total enrollment is forecasted to increase by 105 students, or 14.6%, between 2020-21 and 2025-26.
 - Enrollment is forecasted to then decrease by 17 students or -2.1%, between 2025-26 and 2030-31.
- **In total, enrollment is forecasted to increase by 88 students, or 12.3%, between 2020-21 and 2030-31.**

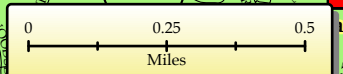
