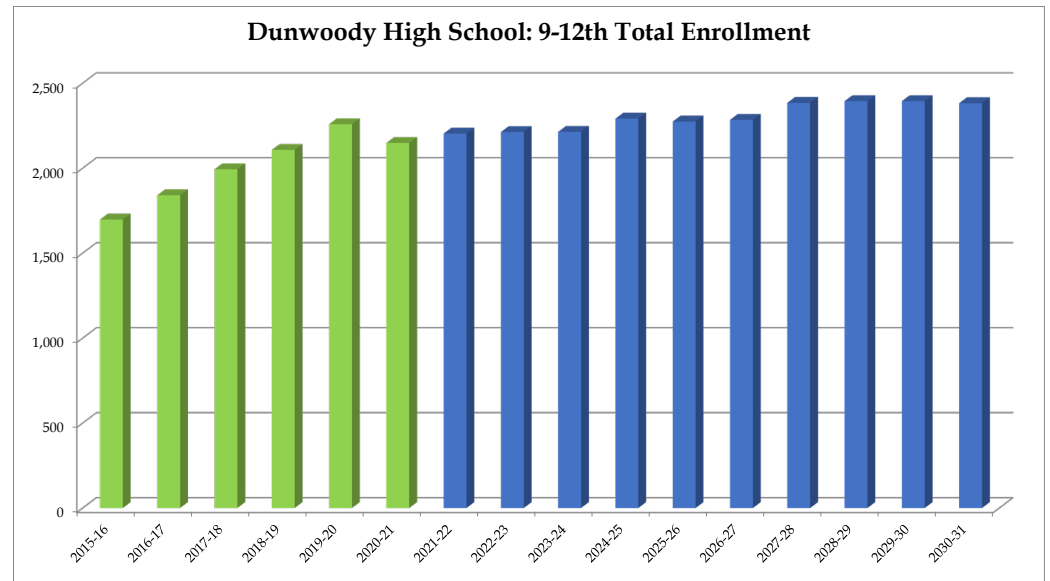

Forecasts developed January 2021

Green cells (2020-2021 and earlier) are historical data

Blue cells (2021-2022 and later) are forecasted years

- Total enrollment is forecasted to increase by 126 students, or 5.9%, between 2020-21 and 2025-26.
 - Enrollment is forecasted to then increase by 108 students or 4.7%, between 2025-26 and 2030-31.
- **In total, enrollment is forecasted to increase by 234 students, or 10.9%, between 2020-21 and 2030-31.**

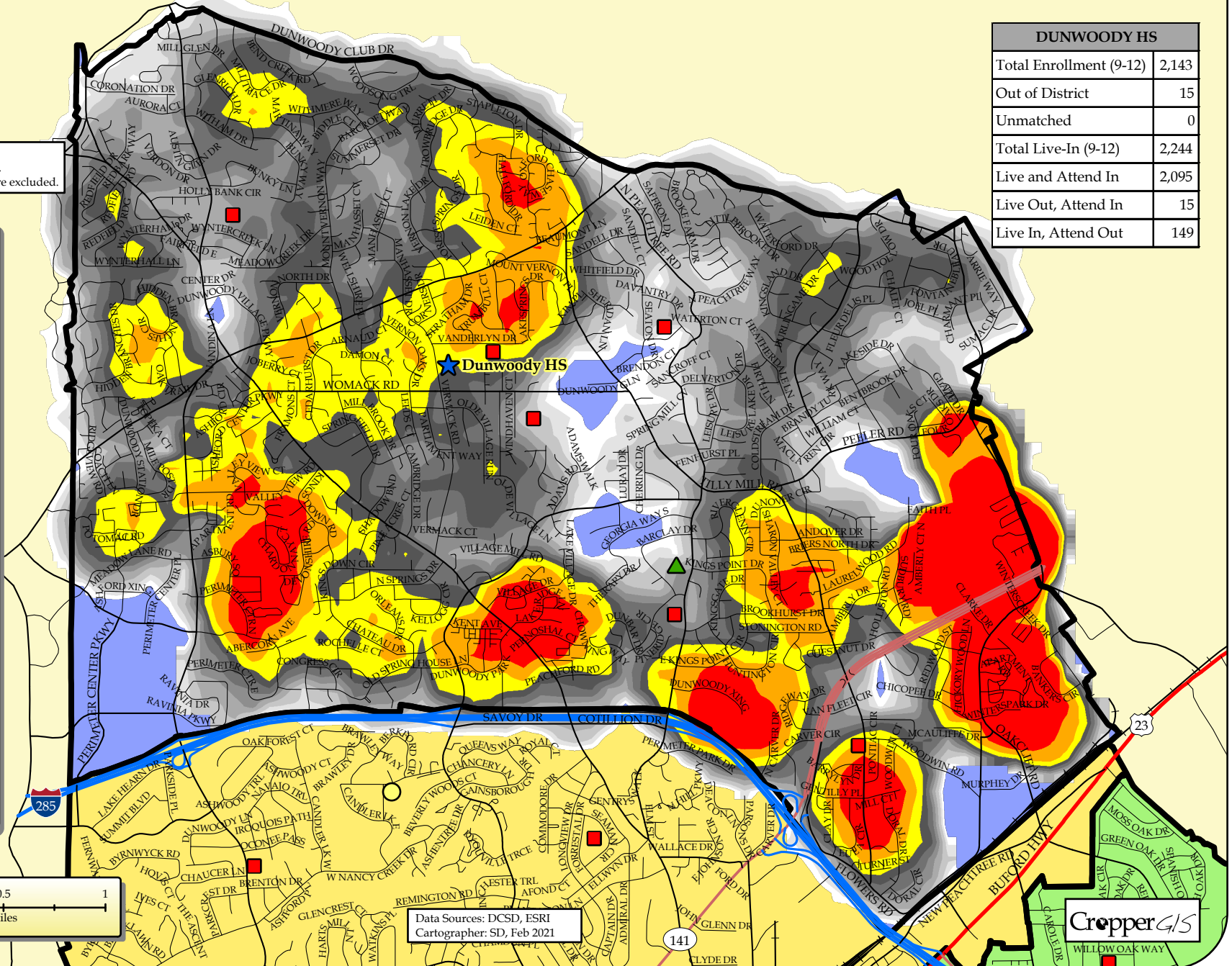
