

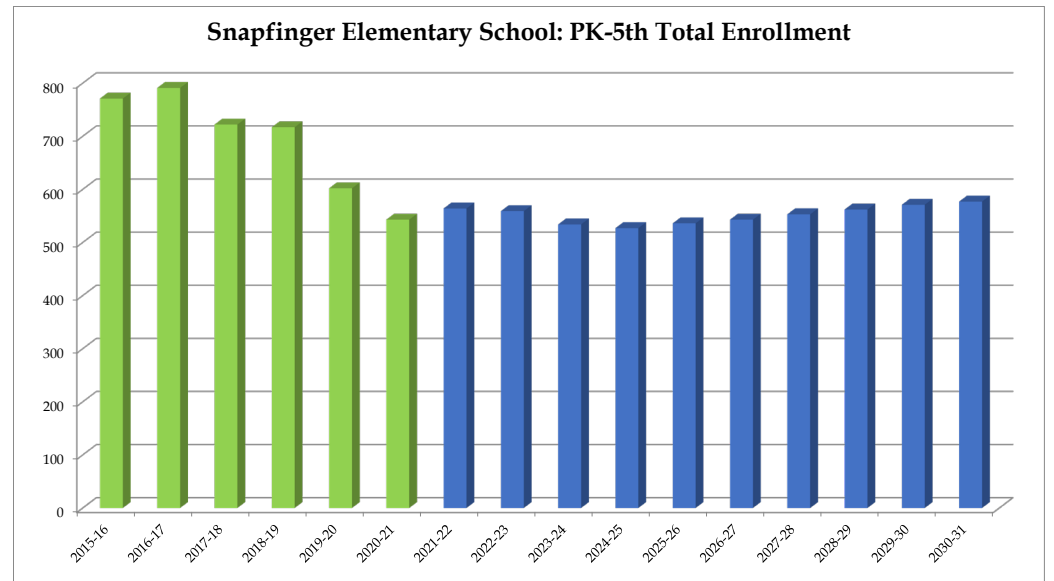

 Blue cells (2021-2022 and later) are forecasted years

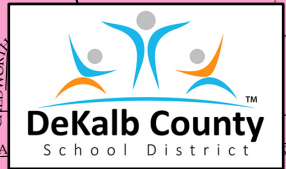
- Total enrollment is forecasted to decrease by 7 students, or -1.3%, between 2020-21 and 2025-26.
 - Enrollment is forecasted to then increase by 41 students or 7.6%, between 2025-26 and 2030-31.
- **In total, enrollment is forecasted to increase by 34 students, or 6.3%, between 2020-21 and 2030-31.**

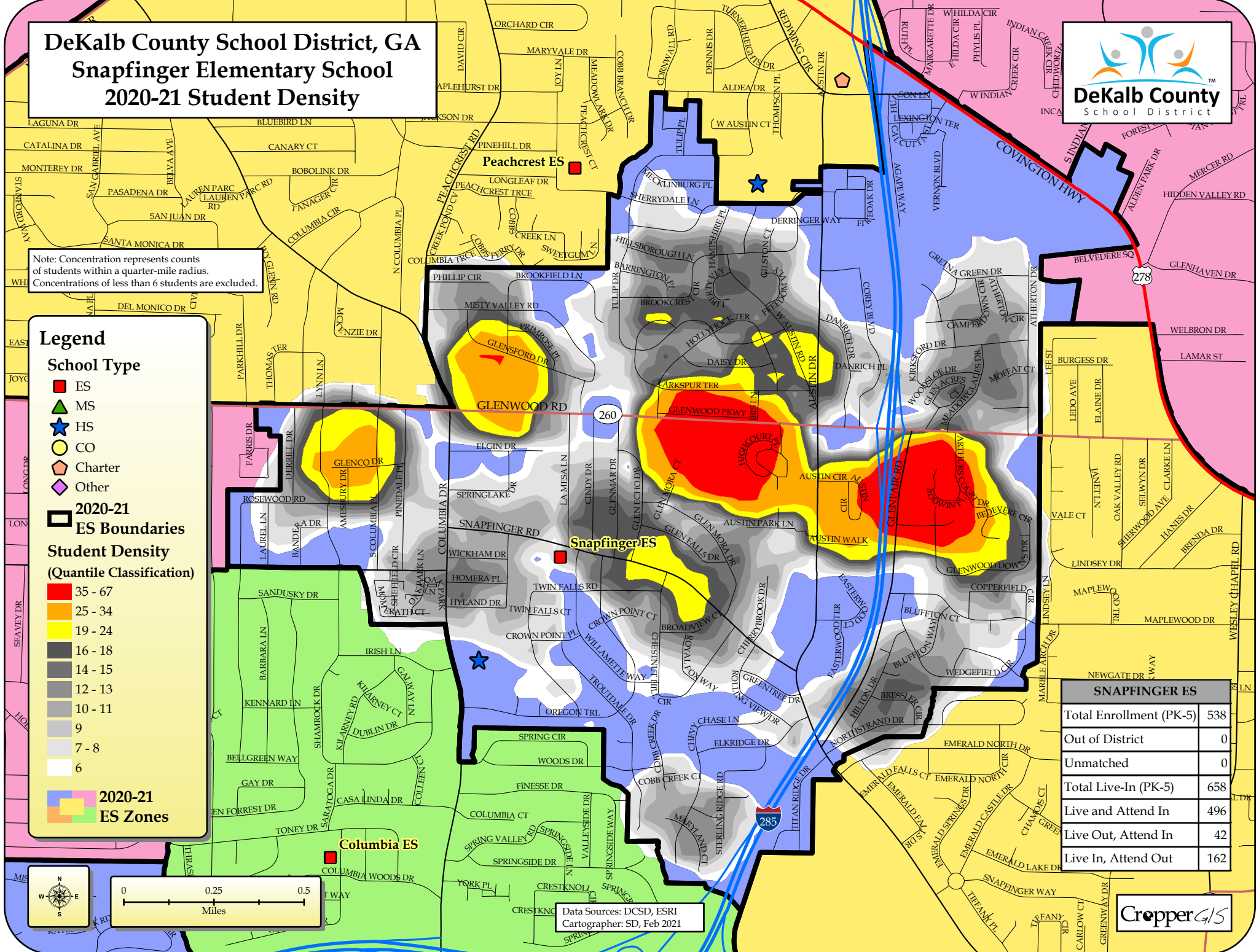
