LAKESIDE'S GLORIOUS BOYS STATE RUN

Lakeside's boys posted one of the most dominating runs on the soccer field in state history from 1973-78, winning state in 1974, 1975 and 1978, losing in the finals in 1973 and 1977 and falling in the second round in 1976.

The Vikings posted a super 18-3 record in state action during that time, with two of the losses being by one goal.

Bob Bills in 1973 (11-2-1) and **Jim Mitchell** from 1974-78 (64-4) registered an amazing 75-6-1 overall mark in the run.

DEKALB COUNTY STADIUMS

Varsity soccer games in DeKalb County are played in the five county stadiums. Directions are listed below.

ADAMS STADIUM: Next to Jim Cherry Center (old Briarcliff High School) at 2415 North Druid Hills Road, Atlanta, Georgia 30329; located two miles east of I-85 north on North Druid Hills Road.

AVONDALE STADIUM: Behind Avondale High School at 1192 Clarendon Road, Avondale Estates, Georgia 30002; located next to the Macy's store at Avondale Mall near the intersection of Memorial Drive and Columbia Drive about two miles inside I-285.

JAMES R. HALLFORD STADIUM: On the campus of DeKalb College, Central Campus at 555 North Indian Creek Drive, Clarkston, Georgia 30021; located four blocks from Memorial Drive outside of I-285.

NORTH DEKALB STADIUM: Behind Chamblee High School at 3688 Chamblee-Dunwoody Road, Chamblee, Georgia 30341; located near Chamblee Plaza Shopping Center, close to the intersection of Chamblee-Dunwoody Road and Peachtree Industrial Boulevard, about three miles inside I-285.

WILLIAM BUCK GODFREY STADIUM: Behind DeKalb College, South Campus, at 2817 Clifton Springs Road, Decatur, Georgia 30034; located off Panthersville Road; exit from I-20 at Candler Road or from I-285 at Flat Shoals Road.

STATE CHAMPIONS

DeKalb County teams have won 16 boys state titles. Lakeside leads the way with seven victorious efforts: Those came in 1970, 1974, 1975, 1978, 1981, 1997 and 2008. Briarcliff is next with three, having won in 1968, 1971, and 1972. Southwest DeKalb claimed consecutive state titles in 1979 and 1980. Peachtree won in 1973. Redan captured the 1988 championship. Henderson took the 1991 title. Chamblee won its first crown in 2008.

GIRLS SOCCER CHAMPIONSHIPS

1982 - Chamblee 2, Redan 1 - Chamblee won the first girls county championship game. The overtime victory which was one hour and forty minutes in length was decided by penalty kicks after the customary overtime and two five-minute sudden death periods. In 1982, only two teams were in the playoffs for the county championship.

1983 - Peachtree 3, Lakeside 1 - Peachtree, winner of the West, defeated Southwest DeKalb 3-2 in the semi-finals. Lakeside, the second place finisher in the West, defeated East winner Redan 3-0 to advance to the final game.

1984 - Lakeside 3, Chamblee 1 - All scoring came in the second half of the championship game. Lakeside goals were scored by Pamela Roberts, Susan Mendelson and Mary Weems, Ingrid Lium scored for Chamblee.

1985 - Stone Mountain 1, Lakeside 0. Debra O'Brien scored the only goal with 25:48 left in the first half. Stone Mountain, undefeated during the regular season, beat Dunwoody 3-0 and tied Clarkston 1-1 in the other classic contests. The Pirates went 12-0-1 while scoring 103 goals and allowing only three. The classic format was the third change in play-off procedure in four years.

1986 - Stone Mountain beat Lakeside, Dunwoody and Clarkston in the DeKalb Classic to finish the season undefeated. The Lady Pirates gave up just one goal during the entire campaign. Bill Kelly's team gave up a goal late in their 3-1 victory over Clarkston in the Classic. Overall the Lady Pirates scored 72 goals.

1987 - Stone Mountain controlled the DeKalb Classic to win a third straight DeKalb County title. The Lady Pirates swept past Peachtree 5-0, Henderson 1-0 and Lakeside 3-0. In the finale, Nicole Canzoneri scored all three goals.

1988 - The first Metro Atlanta Championship playoff was held in 1988. Three of the eight teams invited were from DeKalb. In the championship game, Henderson beat Stone Mountain 2-1 with a come-from-behind win. The loss was the first for the Lady Pirates in four years. Lakeside also made the semi-finals and finished third in what was considered the unofficial girls state tournament.

1989 - The girls playoffs were expanded to 16 teams, four were from DeKalb County. Chamblee and Tucker lost in the first round. Stone Mountain tumbled in the quarter finals. Henderson lost 1-0 to Marist in the semi-finals.

1990 - DeKalb had four teams (Chamblee, Dunwoody, Henderson, Lakeside) in the Metro Atlanta Championship playoff. Henderson and Lakeside advanced to the second round before being eliminated.

1991 - Four teams qualified for the Metro Girls Tournament. Dunwoody beat Heritage and Stone Mountain defeated Pope to advance to the quarter finals where both teams were eliminated.

1992 - Four teams qualified for the Metro Tournament. Dunwoody and Tucker lost first round games. Stone Mountain and Lakeside fell in the quarter finals.

1993 - Lakeside, Stone Mountain, Tucker and Dunwoody qualified for the State tournament. Only Lakeside survived the first round. The Lady Vikings shut out Lovett and Brookwood before losing to Pace 2-1 in the semi-finals.

1994 - Stone Mountain made it to State semi-finals where they lost 1-0 to Fayette County with 1:50 remaining in the second overtime. Tucker made it to the second round. Lakeside and Dunwoody also qualified for the state.

1995 - Stone Mountain, the 7AAAA champions, lost to Walton High School and Dunwoody lost to Fayette County in the first round.

1996 - Redan and Lakeside lost in the first round of the state. Stone Mountain clobbered Clarke Central in the first round, then lost to Pope.

1997 - Redan won the 7AAAA championship and Tucker took the 5AAA crown. Marist beat Lakeside 3-0 for the 6AAA title. Redan, Tucker and Stone Mountain lost first round State tournament games. Lakeside reached the finals and lost to Marist by a score of 1-0.

1998 - Lakeside was one of four DeKalb teams to make the State Tournament. The Lady Vikings beat Eastside 12-0, defeated North Gwinnett 1-0 in overtime. It was the 12th shutout for the top ranked team in the State. In the semifinals, Lakeside lost to Starr's Mill 2-1 in two overtimes.

1999 - Lakeside beat McEachern, but then lost to Pope. Both Clarkston and Tucker were shut out in the first round.

2000 - Stone Mountain lost to Rome 9-0 in the first round of the state Class AAA tournament.

2001 - Lakeside lost to Duluth (2-1), Stephenson fell to Brookwood (14-0), Redan came up short against Shiloh (11-0) and Southwest DeKalb fell by a 15-0 margin to Parkview in the first round of the state Class AAAAA tournament. Tucker also dropped a 3-0 decision to Sequoyah in the opening round of state on the AAAAA level.

2002 - Lakeside dropped a painful 1-0 decision to Norcross, Stephenson fell by a 16-1 margin to Brookwood and Redan lost a 15-0 encounter against Parkview in opening round AAAAA action as DeKalb's lone three state qualifiers.

2003 - Lakeside fell by a 6-0 count to Chattahoochee and Stephenson dropped a 15-0 decision to Centennial in opening round AAAAA state action. Druid Hills registered a 1-0 victory over Cedar Shoals and lost by the same 1-0 margin to Forsyth Central as the main highlight from the AAAAA state wars. Columbia also came up short 15-0 against Heritage in AAAAA, while Towers failed to show in dropping a forfeit decision to Grayson in its state debut in AAA.

2004 - Seven DeKalb County teams earned state tournament berths in 2004. Lakeside came up short by a 2-0 margin in a defensive battle against Lassiter in the first round of state Class AAAAA tournament action. Stephenson lost 12-0 to Chattahoochee and Southwest DeKalb dropped a 13-0 decision to Pope in other AAAAA opening round contests. In AAAA state results, Druid Hills lost a heart-breaking 1-0 overtime decision to Salem and Stone Mountain and Martin Luther King Jr. dropped identical 15-0 matchups against Rockdale County and Heritage respectively in the first round. Towers lost 13-0 to Grayson in the first round of AAA action.

SOCCER HISTORY

Soccer became part of the Georgia High School Association's interscholastic athletic program in 1965-66. DeKalb County joined the program in 1967-68 for the regular GHSA winter season. In 1970, a fall league was established for smaller schools who did not participate in football. In 1979, the winter season was moved to spring. The first two state championship tournaments were held at Emory University. When DeKalb County joined the program, a majority of tournament games were held at the DeKalb County stadiums.

Briarcliff was the first DeKalb County team to win a state championship in soccer. The Barons defeated Bass and Westminster to advance to the title game in 1968. Briarcliff and North Springs tied 1-1 and were declared co-champions after eight overtime periods. Two years later, Lakeside beat North Springs 1-0 to win the state crown outright. The following season Briarcliff again was declared co-champion after tying Darlington 2-2. In 1972, Briarcliff won the championship game. The Lakeside Vikings came back to take the state crown in 1974 and 1975 with powerful teams. They were eliminated in the quarterfinals in 1976 and lost in the championship game in 1977. Lakeside won the 1978 state crown with a 3-1 win over Druid Hills. Southwest DeKalb took the 1979 crown. The Panthers made it back-to-back titles in 1980 as they edged Redan 2-1. Redan made it to the finals again in 1981, only to lose to Lakeside 2-1.

In 1988, DeKalb County had an incredible year. The final four teams for the state championship were all from DeKalb. Redan defeated Druid Hills 3-0 for the state crown. Clarkston finished third and Shamrock fourth. Five times in the 23-year history, DeKalb had three teams in the final four. But 1988 was the first time all four had come from the same county. The girls completed the sweep. Three teams invited to the first ever Girls Metro Championship were from DeKalb. Henderson handed Stone Mountain its first loss in three years with a 2-1 come-from-behind victory in the unofficial girls state championship game. Stone Mountain finished second and Lakeside was third.

In 1989, Lakeside and Henderson made it to the quarterfinals. Lithonia fell to Lovett in the semifinals. Despite three goals by **Brad Beckham**, Clarkston lost to Lovett in the championship game 4-3. DeKalb had four teams in the girls playoffs. Henderson lost to eventual state champion Marist 1-0 in the semifinals.

Clarkston and Redan made it to the semifinals in 1990. DeKalb had four girls teams in the Metro Atlanta championship. Henderson and Lakeside made it to the second round.

Henderson (13-3-1) brought DeKalb County its 13th state soccer crown in 1991 with a 1-0 win over Fayette County. In the girls metro tournament, Dunwoody and Stone Mountain made it to the quarterfinals.

DeKalb County had four teams stopped in the 1992 state quarterfinals. Stone Mountain and Redan were shut out. The Lakeside and Stone Mountain girls suffered the same fate in the Metro Tournament. Redan, Shamrock, Clarkston and Stone Mountain all won first round games in the 1993 boys state soccer tournament. Stone Mountain lost to Heritage in the quarterfinals. In girl's competition, Lakeside went 10-0 during the regular season, outscoring their opponents 49-5. In the playoffs, the Lady Vikings had four straight shutouts before losing a 2-1 semifinal match to Pace. **Monica Jarvis** of Tucker became the first girl to lead the county in both goals and assists two years in a row.

Under a new format in 1994, Redan and Stone Mountain qualified for the state Class AAAA tournament. Henderson and Lakeside qualified in AAA. Stone Mountain won Area 7AAAA and Lakeside was the Area 6AAA champion. Henderson (15-2-1) made it all the way to the state finals losing 3-0 to Lovett. Girls teams making it to the state were Lakeside, Dunwoody, Tucker and Stone Mountain.

The Stone Mountain boys and girls won Area 7AAAA titles in 1995. Both were eliminated in the first round of the state tournament. The Redan boys and Dunwoody girls also lost in the first round.

Records tumbled in 1996. **Lawrence Shelley** and **Lesley Roberts** of Lithonia set new marks. Shelley with 50 goals and Roberts with 32 assists. **Joline Charlton** of Redan set a new girls record with 31 assists and tied the goals record with 41. The Dunwoody and Henderson boys won first round games in the state tournament. Stone Mountain's girls also advanced to the second round.

Lakeside carried the banner for DeKalb County in 1997. The Viking boys team (16-2-2) tied St. Pius 0-0 for the state Class AAA championship. In the state championship game, penalty kicks do not determine the winner. After two ten-minute overtime periods, co-champions are declared. St. Pius came into the playoffs ranked No. 1 in the nation and averaging seven goals a game. Coach **Carol Gornowicz**'s Lakeside girls squad shut out three straight opponents to reach the title match before dropping a tough 1-0 decision to Marist.

The Lakeside girls went to the state semifinals in 1998, where they lost to Starr's Mill 2-1 in two overtimes. DeKalb had four girls and two boys teams in the state tournament. Only the Lakeside girls advanced past the first round.

A strong Lakeside girls team lost to Pope in the second round in 1999. Druid Hills was the only boys team to advance to the second round. **Joline Charlton** concluded her career by leading the county in goals scored for the fourth straight year. The Redan senior was also the county assist leader.

DeKalb County realized a first in soccer during the 2008 season, as two boys teams claimed state titles. Coach **Rick Barbe**'s Lakeside squad prevailed over Southeast Whitfield in AAAA in a shootout, winning 3-1 after a scoreless regulation and two overtime periods. The Vikings lost only to Marist (1-0) in an otherwise spectacular campaign of 20-1-1. Coach **Uwe Neuhaus** guided Chamblee to the boys AAA crown, as the Bulldogs knocked off Region 5AAA rival and No. 1 ranked Westminster by a 2-1 count in the final. The Bulldogs finished with a 16-3-2 record. Stone Mountain junior **Rury Alvarez** broke the county boys record for goals scored with 56, while Stone Mountain sophomore **Jose Cruz** tied the old boys county mark for assists with 32.

2020 BOYS SEASON IN REVIEW

DeKalb County was bracing for another banner season on the soccer field when Covid-19 struck and ended the dreams of many powerful local teams.

Lakeside, in particular, appeared to be primed for a long state playoff run, having shot out of the gates to a stellar 6-0-2 start a year after advancing all the way to the state Class AAAAAAA championship contest.

Merck Smith returned to his high school roots as the Viking head coach for the first time and had his old school right in the thick of a region championship in a loaded 7-AAAAAAA draw that also included such traditional powers as Brookwood and Parkview along with Berkmar, Meadowcreek, Norcross and Central Gwinnett.

Several other DeKalb County teams were also expected to make a serious run at a state championship, led by Tucker in AAAAAA, Cross Keys and Clarkston in AAAAA and Druid Hills in AAAA.

Coach **Cameron Heyen** had his old high school team at Tucker rolling along at a 7-1-1 clip as the overwhelming early favorite to claim Region 4-AAAAAA regular season honors.

Coach **Otis Reddicks** and coach **Derrick Burgess** guided the Cross Keys Indians to a strong 7-3-1 start, with Clarkston and Chamblee likely looming as the two main challengers to a Region 5-AAAAA crown.

Clarkston had to deal with a coaching change, as long-time head skipper **Andrew Goodman** was not retained after 19 years and a 194-147-12 mark.

The Angoras struggled to a 2-2-2 record through the first six games but still boasted enough talent to peek in time for a push at 5-AAAAAA honors and long postseason run under new head coach **Hugh Broderick**.

Chamblee likewise limped out of the gates to an uncharacteristic 2-4 mark through six games under new head coach **Scott Schwarzer**.

The Bulldogs faced a rugged early schedule that included non-region matches against Decatur, Lakeside, Centennial, Dunwoody, Marist and Wesleyan. That tough slate figure to prime Chamblee for better results as the playoffs inched closer.

Coach **Thomas Bodnar** and the Druid Hills Red Devils always find a way to be in the thick of the state championship hunt and last year was shaping up to be more of the same.

Druid Hills outscored the first eight opponents by an aggregate mark of 34-4 while posting a super 5-1-2 record against one of the toughest schedules in the state.

The Red Devils faced such non-region powers as Paideia, Decatur, Meadowcreek, Atlanta International School and Cross Keys in the first eight games last year, with the future slate also including Westminster, Lakeside, Southeast Whitfield, Tucker and Chamblee along with two Region 4-AAAA giants in Eastside and Woodward Academy.

Other local squads that might have pushed for state playoff berths a year ago included Dunwoody (2-5-1) and Stephenson (5-2-1) in AAAAAA, Arabia Mountain (2-5-1) and Lithonia (6-3) in AAAAA and Stone Mountain (4-4) in AAA.

Individually, early scoring leaders in the county included Lithonia freshman forward-midfielder **Cristian Corona** (18 goals; 3 assists), Stephenson senior forward **Ble Serry** (16 goals; 6 assists), Stone Mountain senior striker-midfielder **Alex Kalombe** (9 goals; 5 assists), Stephenson senior midfielder **Amani Ellis** (6 goals; 8 assists) and senior midfielder **Izaak Clarke** (9 goals) of Druid Hills.

2020 GIRLS SEASON IN REVIEW

DeKalb County felt the frustration of Covid-19 just like the rest of the state a year ago, as play was halted with a little over a month to go in the regular season.

The usual faces were positioning themselves for state playoff berths at the time, led by Dunwoody, Chamblee, Druid Hills, Arabia Mountain and Lakeside.

Coach **Nafis Karim**'s Dunwoody Lady Wildcat sat near the top of the Region 7-AAAAAA standings with a strong 7-2 start to the season.

Chamblee again was primed to push for Region 5-AAAAA regular season honors, as coach **Mattie Kaspar**'s Lady Bulldogs entered the second half of the campaign with a 5-4 overall mark.

Coach **Kai Uchimura**'s Druid Hills Red Devils ranked among the top playoff hopefuls in Region 4-AAAA, posting a 6-3-1 early record in getting primed for later league showdowns with the likes of Woodward Academy, Eastside and Luella.

Coach **Itamar Roberts** and the Arabia Mountain Lady Rams led the county in offensive and defensive production with a 51-4 goal differential mark while storming out of the gates to a 7-1-1 record, with Chamblee looming as the top roadblock in the push for a regular season Region 5-AAAAA crown.

Lakeside, meanwhile, stumbled out of the blocks to an uncharacteristic 2-5 record, but coach **Tim Newmyer**'s Lady Vikings still figured to make a strong state playoff push behind the usual Region 7-AAAAAAA favorites in Brookwood, Parkview and Norcross.

Other DeKalb County teams that figured to be in the thick of the hunt for state playoff berths included Tucker (0-4-1) in 4-AAAAAA, Clarkston (4-5), Lithonia (4-5), Southwest DeKalb (3-4) and Cross Keys (2-5) in 5-AAAAA and Redan (2-3) and Stone Mountain (1-7) in 5-AAA.

The individual offensive leaders over the course of the first half of the season included Lithonia junior forward-midfielder **Kamia Veal** (19 goals), Arabia Mountain junior midfielder **Jahniyah Phillips** (12 goals; 14 assists), Arabia Mountain senior forward **Ashley Phillips** (9 goals; 5 assists), Arabia Mountain senior midfielder **Kendall Franklin** (9 goals; 4 assists) and Columbia sophomore forward **Sara Fletcher** (8 goals; 2 assists).

Arabia Mountain's impressive tandem of junior Zarahiah Robinson (1-0; 0.00 GAA) and sophomore Sinayah Gray (5-1; 0.36 GAA), on the other hand, teamed up to allow only two goals in 560 minutes as the leading goal-keepers in the county.

REGULAR SEASON AND TOURNAMENT INFORMATION

GENERAL INFORMATION:

A. Soccer is a state championship event for boys and girls played in the Spring season. Schools in classes A through 7A are aligned in Regions.

B. All soccer matches will be played according to the rules published by the National Federation, and all National Federation recommendations for "State Adoption" have been adopted by the GHSA. Sub-varsity matches are limited to 35-minute halves.

C. Notification of entry in Class A Soccer must be filed in writing with the GHSA Office no later than April 1, for the upcoming school year so that teams may be placed into Areas for competition. All other classifications are structured according to regions.

D. The number of soccer matches allowed (not including state tournaments) shall be eighteen (18). If a region chooses to play a region tournament, those matches must be included as part of the 18-game total allowed. Beginning and ending dates for practice and competition can be found at the front of this publication.

E. All GHSA varsity soccer matches shall be played with one or more officially-dressed officials who are registered under the GHSA plan for the registration of officials.

F. Teams arriving late for a contest by thirty (30) minutes or more shall forfeit the match, and shall pay the officials unless prior arrangements are made in a timely manner, and both teams agree to start the game late or reschedule it. Consideration will also be given to emergency situations over which the traveling school has no control. The host school has the responsibility of notifying the officials of these changes.

G. A student may not participate in more than three (3) halves of soccer per day except in a tournament setting, when a player may play two full matches in a calendar day.

H. During regular season competition played between teams of different classifications, there will be no overtime procedure invoked when regulation play ends with a tie score, unless both coaches agree and inform the match officials prior to the start of the match. During regular season competition between schools in the same classification, and during region/area and state playoff competition, the overtime procedure described in item "E" later in this section will be invoked.

I. In accordance with the National Federation allowance for a state adoption (Rule 7-1-5), when there is a competitive imbalance between the teams, the match will be shortened as follows:

1. If a team is seven (7) or more goals down at the midpoint of the first half, that will be considered the end of the half, and the teams will play a twenty (20) minute second half.
2. If a team is seven (7) or more goals behind at halftime, the second half will be restricted to twenty (20) minutes.
3. When a team trails by ten (10) or more goals at halftime, the game will be terminated.

J. All soccer matches between schools from the same classification must be played to completion. Matches that are interrupted by weather or mechanical difficulties will be replayed from the point of interruption unless the team that is behind chooses not to complete the match.

K. In accordance with GHSA By-Laws, soccer coaches will be required to attend a GHSA rules clinic. Failure to do so will result in a fine for the school for each coach who does not attend.

REGULAR SEASON AND TOURNAMENT INFORMATION

REGION COMPETITION:

A. When a Region has not adopted its own tie-breaker method, the following Tie-Breaking Procedure will be used for seeding purposes:

1. Record against all teams in the Region.
2. Winning team in head-to-head competition between schools that are tied.
3. Goals allowed in head-to-head competition between schools that are tied.
4. Goal differential in head-to-head competition between schools that are tied (maximum of three (3) goals per game).
5. Goals allowed in all Region games
6. Goal differential in all Region games (maximum of three (3) goals per game). Note: When figuring “goals allowed” and “goal differential” in matches decided by penalty kicks, the winning team will have one (1) goal added to its game score and the losing team will have no goals added regardless of the number of penalty kicks that were made by either team.
7. In any step of the tie-breaking process if a three-way tie is broken so that all ties are broken, that step determines the placements. If two teams remain tied after a step is completed, revert back to head-to-head record to break the tie. If the tie cannot be broken, move to the next step.

B. If Regions sub-divide into Sub-Regions, then the same tie-breaking procedures (A1 through A7) should be used.

C. For Region and State competition, if the score is still tied at the end of the second overtime period, the penalty kick procedure will be used to determine the winner.

D. Financial procedures for all Region playoffs will be determined by the Region. The host school is responsible for payment of officials. The admission fees for State playoffs begin immediately after Region winners are determined.

E. OVERTIME PROCEDURE:

1. The overtime will consist of two (2) ten-minute periods, which will be played to their entirety.
2. A coin toss shall take place to determine which team will put the ball in play for the first overtime period.
3. If the score remains tied following the overtime periods, a “shootout” of penalty kicks will determine the winner.
4. The head referee shall choose the goal at which the penalty kicks will be taken.
5. Each coach will select any five (5) eligible players (including goalkeeper) to take the kicks.
6. A coin toss shall be held with the team winning the toss having the choice of kicking first or last.
7. Teams will alternate kickers, and there is no follow up on the kicks.
8. The defending team may change goalkeepers prior to each kick.
9. Following five kicks from each team, the team with the greater number of successful kicks will be given one (1) point and declared the winner.
10. If the same number of penalty kicks are successful for each team, each coach will select five (5) different eligible players who will kick in a “sudden victory” situation. Each team will have an opportunity to kick in each round of the sudden victory procedure.
11. If there is no “sudden victory” winner after five (5) kicks, the process will be repeated until a winner is determined.

REGULAR SEASON AND TOURNAMENT INFORMATION

STATE COMPETITION:

A. Four teams from each Region in classes A through 7A will advance to the state tournament.

1. Region winners must be determined by the date indicated on the Beginning and Ending Dates table at the front of this publication.

2. It is the responsibilities of the host team to furnish game balls beyond those furnished by the GHSA.

3. In the event that two schools involved cannot agree on the arrangements for the series (dates, times, etc.) the GHSA Executive Director will make a ruling to cover the situation.

4. Prior to the final round, the higher seeded team will host, unless the competing teams have the same seeding. In that case, a coin flip will designate the host team.

5. All Championship games will be played on the dates indicated on the Beginning and Ending Dates table at the front of this publication. Admission prices and exact schedules and sites will be posted on the GHSA web site prior to the finals.

6. At neutral-site games, each participating team is allowed free admission for a maximum of 25 players and team essential personnel. Coaches will be admitted with a GHSA coaching pass.

B. Finances:

1. The GHSA will receive 12% of the gross gate receipts.

2. A pre-set amount for game officials fees will be sent to the GHSA office, along with the 12% of gross gate receipts, and the GHSA office will be responsible for paying the officials.

3. The visiting team shall be paid \$.80 per mile (one way) for travel.

4. After these three expenses are paid the schools involved will share the remaining gate receipts equally.

5. The host school is responsible for security, facility fees, maintenance costs, etc., and these expenses shall not be taken out of gate receipts.

C. Admission must be charged at all playoff games. Beginning immediately after Region winners are determined, fees for single playoff games prior to the Championship Finals are \$7.00. Doubleheaders will be \$10.00.

D. In order to host a state playoff game, the following site requirements must be met:

1. Seating requirements (seats at 24 inches each): A & 2A: 750; 3A: 1,000; 4A: 1,500; 5A, 6A & 7A: 2,000.

2. Adequate restroom facilities must be provided.

3. Dressing area must be provided for the visiting team and the officials.

4. The playing area must be configured in such a way that spectators must enter through an admission gate.

5. The field must be sufficiently lighted to allow for night play for all semifinal and championship matches.

6. Championships matches will be held at centralized sites.

E. In the post-season tournaments, it is necessary to have team benches located on the same side of the field. This will be true even in situations where fans are kept on opposite sides of the field.
