LAKESIDE REGAINS ALL-SPORTS TROPHY TROPHY

Strong showings in cross country, swimming and soccer helped Lakeside return to the head of the class in the annual DeKalb County All-Sports Trophy race in the 2020-21 school year. The all-sports triumph was the first in eight years for a Viking machine that captured the same award an impressive 12 times over 18 seasons from 1995-96 to 2012-2013.

SOFTBALL HISTORY

DeKalb County served as one of the main forerunners in the introduction of fastpitch softball as a sanctioned sport on the high school level.

While the slowpitch version of the game has held state championships since 1981, fastpitch softball did not make its inaugural appearance until the fall of 1993.

Local schools dominated the field in that first season, as 18 of the 21 teams hailed from DeKalb County. Marist, Berkmar and Meadowcreek were the remaining three entrants.

Dunwoody put together an impressive run as the initial powerhouse in the sport, finishing either first or second in the state in each of the first four years.

Co-coaches **Lynn Maddox** and **Cheryl Finke** guided the Lady Wildcats to a super 101-15 record during that stretch. Dunwoody won at least 17 games every year from 1993-98.

The initial 1993 campaign featured a memorable battle between Dunwoody and Meadowcreek for what was then listed as the Metro Championships.

Dunwoody opened that tournament in dominating fashion, posting three straight shutout triumphs over Lithonia (9-0), Redan (6-0) and Berkmar (5-0) to advance to the championship round.

Matched up against Meadowcreek in best-of-three series, the Lady Wildcats fought to the very end before coming up just short in their pursuit of the first and only metro crown.

Dunwoody actually gained the early advantage by pulling out a 2-1 nailbiter in the first game of the showdown. Meadowcreek, however, bounced back to sweep the last two contests by the narrow respective margins of 12-9 and 2-1.

The Lady Wildcats used that heart-breaking defeat as inspiration in what would prove to be the first of their two state championship runs in 1994.

After posting a super 22-3 record in the regular season, Dunwoody rolled past Lassiter (3-1), Tucker (13-2), Brookwood (3-0) and Brookwood (7-3) again in a perfect 4-0 state march.

Overpowering sophomore southpaw **Adrienne Fortmann** capped a stellar 15-2 season on the mound, striking out six and allowing only two hits in picking up the pitching victory.

Junior shortstop **Sabrina Touchberry** (3-4, 2 RS), sophomore centerfielder **Amy Thompson** (2-4) and junior third baseman **Megan Galhouse** (2-4), meanwhile, shined brightest offensively for the Lady Wildcats.

Other key players for Dunwoody included junior catcher **Nancy Diamond**, sophomore pitcher-second baseman **Ashley Fawcett**, junior leftfielder **Shana Vidal**, freshman first baseman **Melissa Chastney** and freshman rightfielder **Jessica Tucker**.

Coach **Pat Floyd** and the Tucker Lady Tigers nearly joined Dunwoody in the championship round, dropping a 9-3 heartbreaker in 11 innings to Meadowcreek in the semifinals.

Freshman pitcher **Jill Wilkinson** (20-5), senior shortstop **Krissy Streid** and junior outfielder **Teresa Eubanks** led the charge for a Tucker squad that went 3-2 at state and finished 24-5 overall.

Redan also qualified for state in 1994, dropping two straight tough decisions to Brookwood (2-1) and Meadowcreek (2-0). Senior southpaw **Mandy Smart** was brilliant on the mound in defeat for the Lady Raiders.

Dunwoody nearly earned a second straight state championship in 1995, settling for runnerup honors after a stunning loss to Douglas County in the championship round.

The Lady Wildcats whipped Berkmar (9-1), Brookwood (7-3) and Parkview (8-1) to advance to the final, before dropping two consecutive decisions of 3-0 and 8-2 to Douglas County in finishing 29-5 overall.

A brilliant group of seniors, though, made up for that disappointment by climbing to the top of the state field for the second time in three years at the 1996 AAAA tournament.

Maddox was able to retire from the coaching ranks in style, as Dunwoody won three straight one-run decisions over Lassiter (2-1), Shaw (1-0) and Berkmar (3-2) and then easily rolled past Lassiter (6-0) again in the championship contest in wrapping up a memorable 27-4 season.

Fortmann struck out three and allowed only one hit in the final blitzing of Lassiter, while Thompson, Tucker and freshman shortstop **Nikki Reed** paced a balanced offense that received key contributions from several individuals.

Chamblee also earned a state berth on the AAA level in 1996, losing consecutive tough decisions to Columbus (5-4) and Douglas County (6-0) while getting eliminated in two games and finishing 19-10 overall for the season.

Tucker next ended a four-year dry spell for DeKalb County schools by advancing to the state Class AAAA tournament in 2001.

The Lady Tigers posted a 1-2 record at that battle on the way to finishing 31-4 overall. Super junior pitcher **Christy Wahl** established a new county strikeout record of 445 in leading a stellar campaign.

Martin Luther King Jr. garnered the next state berth for DeKalb County schools while advancing to the AAA tournament in 2004. Coach **Paris Burd**'s Lions went 1-2 there and finished 24-10 overall.

The 2017 season offered the biggest highlight in many years, as four DeKalb County squads advanced to the second round of the state tournament for the first time in county history.

Region 5-AAAAA led the way with three teams moving on, as league champion Arabia Mountain, No. 2 seed Chamblee and No. 3 entrant Miller Grove advanced and Dunwoody impressed in a first round sweep as well.

Both Arabia Mountain (23) and Chamblee (22) established school records for single season victories in 2017 to add to the long list of impressive achievements on the local level.

2020 SOFTBALL IN REVIEW

In a season that began with the frustrations of Covid-19 and ended with the retirement of Southwest DeKalb's legendary 20-year head coach **Bernice Foreman**, DeKalb County still managed to post some impressive results on the softball diamond in 2020.

Local schools originally were set to throw out the first pitch on Aug. 6. Several postponements later, and it actually was Sept. 28 before the first game was played. That's 53 days after the fact, or well over seven weeks.

The first contest of 2020 featured Chamblee hosting old neighborhood rival Dunwoody, with the host school jumping out to a 2-0 lead and holding onto that until late in the game. The visiting Lady Wildcats, however, erupted for eight unanswered runs down the stretch to pull out the highly anticipated opener by a final count of 8-2.

From first pitch to the final out of Cedar Grove's Oct. 15 road contest at Westminster, the entire regular season schedule lasted only 18 days for DeKalb County squads.

Local entrants managed to survive the challenging circumstances, as eight of the nine teams that fielded a team advanced to the state tournament.

Southwest DeKalb was included among those state qualifiers from DeKalb County, snaring a berth to the big dance as the runner-up from Region 5-AAAAA.

Foreman's 20th and final Lady Panther edition knocked off a strong Chamblee team in the first round of the Region 5-AAAAA tournament, eventually securing second place following a 7-2 loss to St. Pius in the final.

Southwest DeKalb hosted Apalachee in the opening round of state, falling by the respective scores of 15-0 and 16-0 to finish 4-5 overall on the short season.

The state trip was the eighth straight and 10th overall for the Lady Panthers under the respected veteran coaching tandem of Foreman and **Jerry White**.

Southwest DeKalb had never reached the state tournament in the first 15 years that the sport was sanctioned as a state championship sport by the Georgia High School Association from 1994-2008, finally breaking through during the historic 9-11 campaign of 2009.

Foreman posted double digit victory totals in 15 of her 20 seasons at the helm of the Lady Panther program, led by the especially standout showings of the 2013 (18-6), 2014 (17-7), 2019 (16-9), 2010 (15-6), 2004 (14-6) and 2010 (14-10) teams.

Only Dunwoody's **Kerry Brown** (263-206) posted more victories as a DeKalb County head coach than Foreman, who led Southwest DeKalb to state tournament berths in 2009, 2010, 2013, 2014, 2015, 2016, 2017, 2018, 2019 and 2020 on the way to registering a stellar final overall record of 239-160.

Lakeside proved to be the lone DeKalb County team to finish with a winning final record, finishing 7-4 overall under the leadership of rookie head coach **Brian Granger**.

The Lady Vikings finished second to North Atlanta in Region 4-AAAAAA, hosting and falling to Northside Warner Robins by the identical scores of 12-0 and 12-0 in the first round of the state class AAAAAA tournament.

Seniors **Mack Blair** (.742 BA; 20 RBI; 12 RS; 3 HR; 10 2B), **Sara Mirabel** (.560 BA; 12 RBI; 9 RS) and **Brady Miccichi** (.452 BA; 20 RBI; 15 RS; 5 2B; 4 3B) led a dominating Lakeside offense that ranked second in the county with a .422 batting average, while Mirabel went 6-2 on the pitching mound.

Tucker also soared to a state tournament berth out of Region 4-AAAAAA, reaching the big show for only the third time in school history and the first since 2001 or 19 years earlier.

Coach **Jonathan Farley**'s Lady Tigers faced a powerful Lee County team in the first round of state, falling in both ends of a doubleheader by the respective scores of 15-0 and 17-0.

Tucker led the county in hitting with a .442 final mark in finishing 5-6 as a team, with junior **Xya Hicks** (.680 BA; 18 RS; 10 RBI; 3 2B), junior **Andriya Hunter** (.615 BA; 17 RS; 13 RBI; 5 2B; 2 3B), sophomore **Alyssa Walker** (.567 BA; 13 RS; 4 2B) and junior **Flora Vogel** (.480 BA) pacing the offense and Vogel (5-5; 10.13 ERA) handling the majority of the pitching duties.

Dunwoody reached the state tournament for the 11th time in the last 12 years, surviving a rugged Region 7-AAAAAA field on the way to earning a road trip to North Forsyth in the first round under the leadership of rookie head coach **Jake Hill**.

Hill's inaugural Lady Wildcat squad battled North Forsyth to the finish in the AAAAAAA draw before getting swept by the scores of 8-0 and 11-7 and finishing 5-7 overall on the year.

Dunwoody boasted a powerful offense that included four starters hitting over .300 in junior **Molly Kotzin** (.600 BA; 19 RBI; 13 RS; 3 HR; 4 2B), sophomore **Ryan Boaz** (.400 BA), junior **Gracie Puckett** (.394 BA; 16 RS; 3 2B) and junior **Abby Hughes** (.321 BA).

Chamblee joined Southwest DeKalb as a second entrant for state out of Region 5-AAAAA, entering as the third seed under head coach **Alan Loper**.

Loper's Lady Bulldogs drew traditional power Loganville in the first round of the AAAAA tournament, falling by the respective scores of 8-0 and 12-2 in finishing 5-5 overall on the year.

Sophomore **Parker Smith** (.375 BA), sophomore **Savannah Russell** (.350 BA; 10 RS; 3 2B) and freshman **Shea Parker** (.300 BA) paced the offense and junior **Margaret Axelson** (4-3; 1.88 ERA; 54 SO; 37 1/3 IP) and sophomore **Lily McCord** (1-2; 4.45 ERA; 30 SO; 22 IP) formed an imposing mound tandem.

Druid Hills and Arabia Mountain in AAAA and Cedar Grove in AAA rounded out the lengthy list of state playoff qualifiers from DeKalb County in 2020. All four entrants were swept in two straight games in the first round.

REGULAR SEASON AND TOURNAMENT INFORMATION

A. Fast Pitch Softball is a state championship event organized on a Region basis in seven classifications. In Class A, there will be separate championships for public and private schools. Beginning and ending dates for practice and competition can be found at the front of this publication.

B. All softball games will be played by the rules as published by the National Federation of State High School Associations.

C. The maximum number of softball games allowed (not including state tournament games) shall be: thirty (30) games either head-to-head competition or in invitational or region tournaments.

1. Region tournaments shall be structured so that no school will play more than eight (8) games in that tournament.
2. Schools may not enter any softball tournament other than the region tournament or state elimination series unless such tournament has been approved by the GHSA Executive Director.
3. Sub-varsity teams are allowed to play 70 percent of their respective varsity team's regular season games. Sub-varsity teams shall not schedule a tournament after they have reached their 70 percent game restriction.
4. Contracts are required for all GHSA member school fastpitch softball games, including invitational tournaments.

D. All varsity softball games shall be played with officially-dressed officials who are registered under the GHSA plan for the registration of officials. The assignment of officials for regular-season games, invitational tournaments, and sub-region and region tournaments will be made by the GHSA office.

1. The GHSA will assign one or more associations to each school for their games.
2. The school and the local association(s) will sign a contract for the games that are assigned.

E. The following rule "State Adoptions" have been approved for GHSA play in softball:

1. The game will end when:
 - (a) a team has completed three turns at bat and is fifteen (15) runs behind.
 - (b) a team has completed four turns at bat and is twelve (12) runs behind.
 - (c) a team has completed five or more turns at bat and is eight (8) runs behind.
2. The courtesy runner rule has been adopted. NOTE: Participation as a courtesy runner does not constitute entry into the game, and does not count as a game played.
3. The use of a double first base is recommended.
4. The suspended game rule will be used.
 - (a) When a game is stopped before it becomes a legal game, it is considered to be "no contest" and any replay will begin from the first inning.
 - (b) When a game is stopped after it becomes a legal game and a winner can be determined, the game is completed.
 - (c) When a game is stopped after it becomes a legal game and a winner can not be determined, any replay will begin from the point of interruption.
 - (d) Exception: If a State Tournament game is suspended at any point, it shall resume from the point of interruption on the next available date. If that date can not be agreed upon by the competing schools, the GHSA Executive Director shall determine the playing date.
5. Termination of the game due to weather, unplayable conditions, or mechanical malfunctions:
 - (a) The umpires may halt play for up to two (2) hours when conditions do not allow play to continue.
 1. The two-hour interruption(s) is cumulative
 2. The game must be terminated when the two-hour time period has elapsed. If the first game of a doubleheader is terminated, the second game will be postponed.
 3. The two-hour period does not include time needed to prepare the field for the resumption of play.
 - (b) Umpires must wait for at least 30 minutes before terminating a game for unplayable field conditions.
6. In any softball game, if a team does not show up within 30 minutes of the scheduled game time, a forfeit shall be declared unless the delay is unavoidable and the visiting team notifies the home team. In emergency situations, the game may be started late, or may be rescheduled.
7. In order to be used, the tie-breaker procedure shall be agreed upon by both teams during the pregame meeting with the umpires. If implemented, the procedure shall begin in the 10th inning (and any subsequent half-inning). Exception: In Invitational Tournament games with a "time limit" policy, the tie-breaker procedure would start in the subsequent inning after time had expired. If not agreed upon, games may end in a tie after seven (7) full innings, or after time had expired during invitational tournament games.
8. Only game-essential personnel are permitted within the confines of the team's dugout and shall be held to the same level of accountability as the coaching staff and players.
9. Sub-varsity games may have a time limit instead of playing seven innings as long as the guidelines are agreed upon before the start of the game.
10. Varsity games played in invitational tournaments may have time limits as follows:
 - (a) No game may be less than five innings regardless of the time limit (4.5 innings if home team is ahead.)

REGULAR SEASON AND TOURNAMENT INFORMATION

(b) No time limit may be less than 90 minutes.

11. Same-day multiple games, using the same umpires, shall receive the doubleheader game fee listed in the Appendix "F" Game Fee Chart.

12. Host schools are required to post the current USA SOFTBALL list of "Non-Approved" bats in both dugouts during GHSA sanctioned games.

F. Teams may have spring try-outs that are limited to a maximum of five consecutive school days between May 1 and the last day students are in school. Students must be academically eligible and enrolled at the school they are trying out for, or be an 8th grader at a feeder school for that school. Students currently in the 7th grade (rising 8th graders) may not participate in spring tryouts.

G. Schools must enter team schedules, rosters and weekly game/meet results during the season on MaxPreps and be responsible for updates as needed. This information will support statewide media, event programs, broadcasts partners and GHSA Region Standings. Teams are encouraged to maintain team/individual statistics on MaxPreps.

FAST PITCH REGION/AREA TOURNAMENTS:

A. The dates, times and sites for Region/Area tournaments will be determined by each Region/Area and must be submitted to the Region/Area Coordinator.

B. Each Region/Area will determine its teams advancing to the First Round no later than October 9, 2021, with the top four teams advancing to the First Round in classes A Public through 7A. In Class A Private, the top six teams in each of four Areas will advance to the state playoffs. Teams advancing to the First Round must be submitted to the GHSA office no later than 9:00 a.m., on October 10, 2021.

C. Region post-season games (play-in games, sub-region games, region tournament games) must have a minimum of two (2) games played on each field, each day, with the exception of a championship game.

FAST PITCH STATE TOURNAMENT:

A. For the first two rounds, teams will play a best-of-three series at the site of the higher seed.

1. There will be a doubleheader on the first day and an "if" game on the second day.

a) First Round schedule will be Classes A Public, 4A, 5A & 6A on Oct. 12-13, Classes A Private, 2A, 3A & 7A on Oct. 13-14.

b) Second Round schedule will be Classes A Public, 4A, 5A & 6A on Oct. 19-20, Classes A Private, 2A, 3A & 7A on Oct. 20-21.

2. The host team will be the "home" team for the first game of the series and the visiting team will be "home" team for the second game. The host (higher-seeded) team will be the "home" team for the third game, if necessary.

3. Teams that win the Second Round series will advance to the Elite Eight of the State Tournament.

B. The Elite Eight of the State Tournament will be a double-elimination tournament held in Columbus, Georgia on October 28-30, 2021.

C. Finances for all state playoffs are handled as follows:

1. Admission must be charged at all playoff games. For the first two rounds, the admission price for a doubleheader is \$12.00, and \$8.00 for a single game, and the doubleheader shall be played on the first date of the round. For the State Finals, the admission price will be \$15.00 per day.

2. The GHSA will receive 12% of the gross gate receipts at all state playoff games.

3. In the First and Second Rounds, the umpires will be paid out of gross receipts (Note: If the gross receipts are not sufficient to pay the umpires, the host school will pay that cost.) The remaining balance is to be divided 50-50 between the two teams. The visiting team shall be paid \$.80 per mile (one way) for travel.

4. Each team is allowed free admission for a maximum of 20 players and team essential personnel. Schools desiring more than this number must pay the admission price. Coaches will be admitted with their GHSA coaching passes.

5. Teams are responsible for their own travel and housing expenses, but housing will be arranged by the Columbus Sports Council for the State Tournament in Columbus.

D. All umpires will be assigned by the GHSA.

E. Times posted with the brackets are approximate. Teams should be ready to take the field for play at the time indicated for each game.

1. The top team in each bracket uses the first base dugout unless a team is playing consecutive games on the same field.

2. The home team will be determined for each game with a coin toss.

3. Lineups should be submitted to the official scorer at least 15 minutes prior to the scheduled starting time.

4. Teams may not use game fields for batting practice.

REGULAR SEASON AND TOURNAMENT INFORMATION

5. All teams advancing to the Elite Eight of the State Tournament are required to be present and in uniform at the Opening Ceremonies. Failure to comply with result in a \$250.00 fine to the school.

F. The outfield fence will be set at 200' from home plate for the State Tournament in Columbus.

G. All teams advancing to the Championship Finals shall be required to have all team bats inspected upon check-in at the championship venue.

1. Bats that pass inspection will have an approved sticker placed on the bat.
2. Bats that do not pass inspection will be confiscated and returned to the team at the conclusion of that team's final game.
3. Bats found to be used in a game that do not have the approved sticker shall be confiscated and the offending player and head coach shall be restricted to the dugout for that game.
