GYMNASTICS HISTORY

The Georgia High School Association instituted gymnastics as a state championship sport for the first time in 1956. The championship was conducted for the boys only in 1956 and from 1964 through 1968. The first girl's state championship was held in 1969. The boy's state championship continued uninterrupted through 1979, with the sport eventually being discontinued in 1987. The girl's state championship is still going strong entering its 44th season.

DeKalb County has certainly made its presence felt, literally ruling the sport over the years while collecting a combined total of 37 state titles between the boys and the girls.

Starting with Druid Hills in 1956, DeKalb County schools won all 17 boys state gymnastics championships that were officially sanctioned over a 32-year period.

Sequoyah had the most impressive streak of this group, winning four consecutive top state prizes from 1969-72. Briarcliff also conquered the field three straight times from 1977-79 and added a fourth crown in 1974, while Druid Hills collected a total of three state trophies in 1956, 1964 and 1965. Gordon (1966 and 1967) and Peachtree (1975 and 1976) won two state championships each. Walker (1968) and Lakeside (1973), on the other hand, each walked away with one boy's state victory.

DeKalb County quickly proved to be equally dominating on the girls front, winning the first 11 officially sanctioned state meets and 20 of 21 big prizes overall from 1969-89.

Lakeside realized special fame during this period, gaining a place in the Guinness Book of World Records by winning nine consecutive state titles from 1971-79.

Lucia Norwood, who once served as Athletic Coordinator for gymnastics and several other sports in the DeKalb County Athletic Department, started this Lady Viking dynasty that has never been equaled over the years.

Norwood guided Lakeside to its initial five state crowns from 1971-75, and **Shirley McDaniel** followed suit as Norwood's successor in the head coaching department by adding four more state trophies to the streak from 1976-79.

Tucker ranks second to Lakeside in the state championship picture, having collected six total first place awards in 1969, 1970, 1982-84 and 1989. **Pat Floyd** was the head coach for the last four of those triumphant performances.

Redan also boasts a brilliant history of excellence on the state level as the owner of the remaining five championship trophies collected by local squads. Coach **George Carden** fostered a Lady Raider run that included claiming the ultimate prize in 1981 and four straight from 1985-88.

Westminster was the only non-DeKalb County team to win a state championship over the first 21 years, that coming at the end of Lakeside's reign in 1980.

The list of local individual champions is a long and impressive one as well. Those who sit at the top of this contingent deserve special recognition for standing out the most in an elite gathering.

Lakeside presented several top stars during its glorious run in the 1970s, with **Barbara Hall** and **Karen Loewen** heading up this long and illustrious contingent.

Hall ruled the local and state field during the middle stages of the decade, highlighted by state all-around triumphs in 1973 and 1976. This wondrous performer actually captured a total of nine state gold medals over her four years of varsity competition.

Loewen, meanwhile, arrived on the scene a few years after Hall's rule, and proceeded to eventually pass her celebrated predecessor in the long run. Tall and remarkably agile, Loewen claimed state all-around crowns in 1979 and 1980 and ended her spectacular career with 10 total state top finishes.

Tucker and Redan, on the other hand, produced the two most accomplished overall state champions in DeKalb County history in **Patty Parker** and **Terri Duffy** respectively.

Parker dominated the local scene for Tucker from 1982-85, sweeping to three state consecutive all-around victories from 1982-84 and 12 total state triumphs. She also snared county all-around honors in 1982 and 1983.

Duffy then completed DeKalb's dominating run of champions in the 1980s, snaring state all-around titles three straight years from 1986-88. The Lady Raider standout also matched Parker for most overall local state titles at 12.

Tucker's **Aimee Schneider**, Lakeside's **Rachel Mann** and Stone Mountain's **Genny King** served as the three leading state stars among local entrants in the 1990s.

Schneider secured state all-around triumphs in 1989 and 1990 and won eight overall state gold's. Mann topped the state all-around field in 1998 and 2000 and won six total state events. King claimed state all-around honors in 1992 and ended her super career with five overall state victories.

Southwest DeKalb entered the list of gymnastics champions for the first time in 2004, winning county team honors. Sophomore **DeAvera Todd** claimed county and state all-around titles to lead the way individually.

REGULAR SEASON AND TOURNAMENT INFORMATION

GENERAL INFORMATION:

- A. Girls gymnastics is a state championship event open to schools in all classifications. There will be two championship divisions: A-5A and 6A-7A.
- 1. Competition in all meets will be held in the following events: (a) Balance Beam (b) Uneven Parallel Bars (c) Vault (d) Floor Exercise (e) All-Around (competition in preceding four events) 2. The order of competition will be determined by block style.
- 3. Open scoring will be used.
- 4. Beginning and ending dates for practice and competition can be found at the front of this publication.
- B. The GHSA gymnastics meets will be played according to the rules published by the National Federation of State High School Associations with such GHSA modifications as may be found in this section.
- C. Each school desiring to participate in gymnastics must file its intent by May 1 of the preceding year by filing the form found on the GHSA web site.
- D. The number of regular-season gymnastics meets allowed is 10, including any invitational tournaments.
- 1. The state elimination series does not count in these meets.
- 2. An invitational tournament is defined as a competition involving more than three teams.
- 3. All invitational tournaments must be approved by the GHSA Executive Director.
- 4. Only two meets per week may be scheduled.
- 5. All teams and gymnasts (except when prevented by injury) must participate in a minimum of three (3) GHSA sanctioned varsity meets during the regular season in order to be eligible to participate in the state Preliminary Meet. If an injury occurs, a doctor's statement with the dates and the type of injury and the release date to participate must be presented prior to the Preliminary Meet. Scan and email the doctor's statement to the penny@ghsa.net.
- 6. Schools may organize and conduct invitational tournaments to assist in meeting the three (3) meet requirement.
- (a) These tournaments may be held outside the school, but must be run by school personnel and must be sanctioned by the GHSA.
- (b) Scores should be submitted to Penny Mitchell by the tournament director as soon as possible to determine rankings to be posted on the GHSA web site.
- E. There will be no interscholastic practice and/or scrimmages.
- F. No exhibitions are permitted during seasonal or invitational meets.
- G. In accordance with NFHS rules, the GHSA limits the number of participants a school may enter in a meet as follows:
- 1. For regular season meets, the limit is five (5) participants per event.
- 2. For invitational meets during the regular season, the limit is four (4) participants per event, unless approved by the tournament director.
- 3. For post-season meets, the limit is four (4) participants per event (including the All-Around competition).
- H. All gymnastics coaches are required to complete an online GHSA rules clinic as specified in the GHSA By-Laws.
- I. Tiebreaker Procedure when using three (3) or more judges.
- 1. Gymnast's scores are determined by dropping the high and low scores and averaging the two middle scores (the scores must be within range per NFHS rules).
- 2. In the event of a tie, an average of all three (3) or four (4) judges' scores will be used.

REGULAR SEASON AND TOURNAMENT INFORMATION

- 3. If a tie still remains, the score of the Chief Judge will be used.
- 4. If, after the above steps, a tie still remains, the tie stands.

PRELIMINARY MEET:

- A. A Preliminary (qualifying) Meet will be held at a site to be determined.
- B. Qualifying Information:
- 1. A total of eight (8) teams will qualify from the A-5A division and eight (8) from the 6A-7A division for the Preliminary Meet by averaging the top three (3) scores during the season. A team's minimum score is determined by compiling the top three (3) individual event scores. In case of a tie for 8th place, the teams tied will qualify for the Preliminary Meet.
- 2. A gymnast may qualify for an individual event even if her team does not qualify by meeting the following standards An all-around score of 34.0 or better in three (3) regular-season meets and/or an individual score of 8.50 or better on Beam and Bars and 9.00 or better on Vault and Floor Exercise in three (3) regular-season meets.
- 3. There will be a limit of four (4) qualifying gymnasts per individual event who can represent a school that did not qualify as a team.
- 4. If a gymnast qualifies at the Preliminary Meet, but can't advance because of illness or injury, the next individual will move up to take that spot at State Finals.
- C. The general information, entry form and roster form may be found on the GHSA website. Coaches must submit rosters online on the GHSA MIS site by March 15. Changes after this date can be sent to the GHSA office for approval. No changes will be made the week of the Preliminary Meet.
- D. Schools that do not meet the entry form deadline will not be able to enter the Preliminary Meet.
- E. All individual competitors must qualify in the Preliminary Meet to advance to the State Finals.
- F. Substitutions made after the Preliminary Meet for team competitors must be on the current submitted roster.
- G. Schools that qualify for the Preliminary Meet, but do not attend, will be fined by the GHSA.
- H. The top four (4) teams in each division, and the top eight (8) individuals in each event and All Around at the Preliminary Meet will advance to the State Finals.

STATE MEET:

- A. The "Dr. Lucia B. Norwood GHSA State Championship" Finals will be held on Friday, April 21, 2023, at a site to be determined. The GHSA Coordinator is Penny Pitts Mitchell in the GHSA office (e-mail: penny@ghsa.net).
- B. In all Preliminary and State Meets, expenses are paid from the gross gate receipts, including the cost of officials, and the balance is sent to the GHSA Office.
- C. In all Preliminary and State Meets, a maximum of 10 athletes and two coaches will be given free admission.

DEKALB COUNTY GYMNASTICS COACHING GIANTS

Whether the team has consisted of boys or girls, DeKalb County boasts a long and impressive line of coaching giants in the sport of gymnastics.

The Georgia High School Association first sanctioned the sport of boys gymnastics in 1956 and later returned the sport to state championship level from 1964-1979.

DeKalb County easily took over as the unquestioned power in this sport, claiming all 16 state team championships during this period.

Superior coaching served as one of the primary factors in helping DeKalb County take control of the boys competition, as **Robert Nowell** led the way among a celebrated list on the local level.

The owner of over 200 (202-134) victories in baseball, Nowell actually became more recognized for his amazing feats in the sport of boys gymnastics.

Nowell first made his mark as the head man at Druid Hills, sweeping to a pair of state and two county team championships in the 1964 and 1965 campaigns.

His Red Devil machine added to that dominating effort on the local scene while rumbling to county team triumphs in 1963, 1964 and 1965.

Nowell moved over to Sequoyah from there and proceeded to skipper the Braves to two straight state titles in 1969 and 1970. He also added victorious county team efforts in both 1969 and 1970 as well.

Saving maybe his best results for last, Nowell skippered a third school in Briarcliff to three consecutive state championships in 1977, 1978 and 1979 and two more county triumphs in 1978 and 1979.

Mark Britt, Bill LoPotro and Mike Cunningham joined Nowell as multiple state championship coaches from DeKalb County with two each.

Britt started that run of excellence with consecutive state golds as the head man at Gordon in 1966 and 1967, adding one county crown to that haul in 1966.

LoPotro followed that up as the next superior coaching face following Nowell at Sequoyah, snaring two state victories in 1971 and 1972 and one county title in 1971.

Cunningham made his name as the head skipper at Peachtree, taking home consecutive state and county championships in 1975 and 1976.

Robert Heck at Druid Hills (1956), Nathan Bedford at Walker (1968), Dan Key at Lakeside (1973) and Bill Crews at Briarcliff (1974) captured one state triumph each, while Kenny Reese at Sequoyah (1980 and 1981) and Virgil Hill at Shamrock (1982 and 1983) won two straight county crowns in also cementing their place among the DeKalb County boys gymnastics coaching legends.

The list of coaching greats from among the girls teams in DeKalb County is equally impressive, leading to 20 state championships in 21 years from 1969-89.

Lakeside owned rare significance in girls gymnastics during that time, earning a place in the Guiness Book of World Records for having won nine straight state championships from 1971-79.

Legendary coach Lucia Norwood began that streak as the leader of the first five victorious Lady Viking gymnastics state winners in 1971, 1972, 1974 and 1975.

Lakeside also won 10 consecutive county team championships from 1972-81, with Norwood serving as the coach of the first four from 1972-75 as well as the 1970 winning squad.

Shirley McDaniel followed Norwood as the Lady Viking head skipper and maintained the level of dominance with four straight state triumphs in 1976, 1977, 1978 and 1979 and seven county team trophies in 1976, 1977, 1978, 1979, 1980, 1981 and 1984.

Pat Floyd and George Carden are two more names that need little mention in recognition of their coaching excellence.

Floyd began and finished her lengthy career as a Tucker Lady Tiger, snaring four state titles in 1982, 1983, 1984 and 1989 and adding five county team victories in 1982, 1983, 1990, 1991 and 1997.

Carden ruled the sport like few before or since as the head coach at Redan in the 1980s, walking away with five state and five county championships.

The Lady Raiders were particular dominating from 1985-89, winning four straight state trophies in 1985, 1986, 1987 and 1988 and five consecutive county titles in 1985, 1986, 1987, 1988 and 1989.

Tucker's **Linda Shilling** claimed two state crowns in 1969 and 1970 and one county in 1969, while Dunwoody's **Cassandra Watkins** also earns mention among the coaching greats with her seven county championships in 1996, 1999, 2001, 2002, 2009, 2010 and 2011.
