## DEKALB COUNTY STADIUMS

Varsity lacrosse games in DeKalb County are played in the five county stadiums. Directions are listed below.

**ADAMS STADIUM:** Next to Jim Cherry Center (old Briarcliff High School) at 2415 North Druid Hills Road, Atlanta, Georgia 30329; located two miles east of I-85 north on North Druid Hills Road.

**AVONDALE STADIUM:** Behind Avondale High School at 1192 Clarendon Road, Avondale Estates, Georgia 30002; located next to the Macy's store at Avondale Mall near the intersection of Memorial Drive and Columbia Drive about two miles inside I-285.

**JAMES R. HALLFORD STADIUM:** On the campus of DeKalb College, Central Campus at 555 North Indian Creek Drive, Clarkston, Georgia 30021; located four blocks from Memorial Drive outside of I-285.

**NORTH DEKALB STADIUM:** Behind Chamblee High School at 3688 Chamblee-Dunwoody Road, Chamblee, Georgia 30341; located near Chamblee Plaza Shopping Center, close to the intersection of Chamblee-Dunwoody Road and Peachtree Industrial Boulevard, about three miles inside I-285.

**WILLIAM BUCK GODFREY STADIUM:** Behind DeKalb College, South Campus, at 2817 Clifton Springs Road, Decatur, Georgia 30034; located off Panthersville Road; exit from I-20 at Candler Road or from I-285 at Flat Shoals Road.

## DUNWOODY PREVAILS IN ALL-SPORTS BATTLE

Impressive results almost across the board elevated Dunwoody to the top of the DeKalb County All-Sports Trophy race last year.

The Wildcats captured all-sports honors for the 16th time in school history, moving them one victory past Lakeside (15) for most team titles since the inception of the award in 1981-82.

## LACROSSE HISTORY

One of the fastest growing sports in the United States, lacrosse became part of the Georgia High School Association state sanctioned championship events during the 2004-05 school year.

Lacrosse has rapidly spread across metro Atlanta since that time, growing from the initial primary settings of Cobb County, north Fulton County and a handful of private schools to the current totals of approximately 90 boys and girls teams.

The state championships first appeared in the spring of 2005, with the designation being an Open event for teams in all classifications.

Lovett dominated the boy's results in the early going, capturing Open titles at the conclusions of the 2005, 2008 and 2009 campaigns.

Lassiter and Westminster, meanwhile, prevented a total domination by Lovett by claiming state victories in 2006 and 2007 respectively.

North Fulton County, on the other hand, grabbed the spotlight on the girls side, as Milton rolled to four consecutive Open Division titles in 2005, 2006, 2007 and 2008 and Chattahoochee added a fifth straight state crown for the area in the 2009 season.

Georgia High School Association then broke up the schools into two classifications for the first time starting with the 2010 campaign, with the AAAAA schools having their own designation and the AAAA, AAA, AA and A teams combining into the other division of A-AAAA.

Milton proceeded to secure two of the first three AAAAA boy's championships, prevailing at the conclusion of the 2010 and 2012 seasons.

Walton broke through for the second state crown from Cobb County with a victorious effort in between Milton's triumphs at the end of the 2011 campaign.

Centennial then brought home North Fulton's first state title in 2013, this one coming in the AAAAAA classification. Roswell added another crown in this class for North Fulton in 2014, and the Hornets repeated as champions in 2015.

Westminster jumped on the top of the medal stand for the second time while taking home the first A-AAAA boys title in 2010 and later added state triumphs in A-AAAAA in 2013 and 2015.

Lambert of Forsyth County made its presence felt with state championship romps through the A-AAAA field in 2011 and 2012. Northview took A-AAAAA honors in 2014.

The girl's competition in the divisional era has consisted of the same two programs sitting at the top in all three years.

Milton swept to state victories on the AAAAA level in 2010, 2011 and 2012 and then in AAAAAA in 2013, 2014 and 2015, giving the Lady Eagles 10 overall crowns in the 11 years of the event.

Westminster has proven to be just as impressive in the A-AAAA field, rolling to state victories in 2010, 2011 and 2012. The Lady Wildcats added a fourth straight state title in the A-AAAAA bracket in 2013. Kell tasted state gold for the first time in A-AAAAA in 2014 and 2015.

DeKalb County entered GHSA state sanctioned lacrosse competition for the first time during the 2012 season, as Druid Hills, Dunwoody, Martin Luther King Jr. and Southwest DeKalb fielded the initial four teams.

Druid Hills, Dunwoody, Martin Luther King Jr. and Southwest DeKalb entered boy's varsity action for 2013, while Dunwoody, Martin Luther King Jr. and Southwest DeKalb fielded girl's varsity squads.

Druid Hills also put together boys and girls junior varsity teams in 2013, and Dunwoody fielded a junior varsity squad for girls.

Lakeside fielded a boys varsity team for the first time in 2015, and the Lady Vikings entered the competition in 2016. Chamblee joined the crowd with a girl's varsity team in 2016 and the Bulldog boys formed a varsity program in 2018.

## **LACROSSE INFORMATION**

### **GENERAL INFORMATION:**

- A. Lacrosse is a classified event with two state championships: classes 6A & 7A combined; and classes A through 5A combined.
- B. All Lacrosse games will be played according to the rules published by the National Federation (boys) or US Lacrosse (girls) with such GHSA modifications as may be found in this section.
- C. Notification of entry in Lacrosse must be filed in writing with the GHSA office no later than April 1, for the upcoming school year so that teams may be placed in Areas for competition.
- D. The number of Lacrosse games allowed (not including state tournaments) shall be eighteen (18). If a region/area chooses to hold a region/area tournament, those games must be included as part of the 18-game total allowed. Beginning and ending dates for practice and competition can be found at the front of this publication.
- E. All GHSA Lacrosse games shall be played with a minimum of two officially-dressed officials who are registered under the GHSA plan for registration of officials.
- F. For evening games, a single game must begin no later than 7:30 p.m., and a doubleheader must begin no later than 6:00 p.m.
- G. Sub-varsity games will be limited as follows:
1. Boys will play four 10-minute quarters.
  2. Girls will play two 20-minute halves.
  3. No overtimes will be played in sub-varsity competition.
- H. When there is a competitive imbalance between two teams in a contest, the game will be shortened as follows:  
If a team is more than ten (10) goals down at any time, the remainder of the game will be played with a running clock that will stop only for timeouts and injuries.
- I. Games that are tied at the end of regulation will be handled according to the procedures outlined in the appropriate rule book as follows:
1. BOYS: Any game that ends in a tie will be resolved by playing a sudden victory overtime period as outlined in Rule 3-4 of the NFHS Boys Lacrosse Rules Book.
  2. GIRLS: For all regular season games in girls lacrosse that end in a tie, overtime will be played according to sudden victory overtime rules (Rule 4-7) published by US Lacrosse and endorsed by the NFHS. This format will also be used in all tournaments where advancement is necessary.
- J. Teams arriving late for a scheduled contest by thirty (30) minutes or more shall forfeit the game, and shall be responsible for payment of the officials unless prior arrangements are made in a timely manner. Consideration will be given to emergency situations over which the traveling school has no control. The host school has the responsibility of notifying the officials of any changes in the schedule.
- K. Schools must enter team schedules, rosters and weekly game/meet results during the season on MaxPreps and be responsible for updates as needed. This information will support statewide media, event programs, broadcasts partners and GHSA Region Standings. Teams are encouraged to maintain team/individual statistics on MaxPreps.

### **AREA COMPETITION:**

- A. Each Area shall have a written tie-breaker procedure in order to seed teams for the playoffs.
- B. An Area may choose to use the GHSA tie-breaker procedure:
7. At any point in the process where ties can be broken so that only two teams remain tied, consideration of head-to-head competition will be invoked. If the tie is completely broken for all teams involved at any step in the process, the tie-breaker process is completed.
- C. If the Area is subdivided, then the same tie-breaker procedure should be used for both subdivisions.

### **POST-SEASON COMPETITION:**

- A. If championship games end with a tie score, the rulebook procedure for breaking that tie is followed (see Lacrosse Section I). school has no control. The host school has the responsibility of notifying the officials of any changes in the schedule.
