Lakeside's impressive list of state tennis champions

From five team crowns to five singles titles to four doubles championships, Lakeside boasts an impressive history in tennis.

Legendary football coach **Wayman Creel** started the winning ways when he took over the tennis program in the spring of 1971

Creel guided the Viking boys machine to state team triumphs in 1980, 1981 and 1982.

Phil Lindsey took over as coach in 1983 and added a team crown for the girls in 1984, while **Chris Smith** netted the final boys title in 2001.

Rick Bodin in 1972, **Kelly Thurman** in 1975 and **Paul Groth** in 1976 claimed individual boys singles victories.

Lianna Bebeau netted consecutive girls singles triumphs in 1983 and 1984, while **Chuck Sobers** and **Jim Duckworth** came out on top in doubles in 1980 and 1981.

Other doubles champions included **Grant Carlson** and **Patrick Highsmith** in 1973 and **Terri Russell** and **Tori Stewart** in 1975.

BALANCED DUNWOODY RETURNS TO ALL-SPORTS CROWN

Strong results almost across the board elevated Dunwoody to the top of the DeKalb County All-Sports Trophy race a year ago for the first time since the 2015-16 school campaign.

The Wildcats captured all-sports honors for the 16th time in school history, moving them one victory past Lakeside (15) for most team titles since the inception of the award in the 1981-82 school year.

TENNIS HISTORY

The state tennis tournament became officially sanctioned in the spring of 1978, with the institution of three boys classifications in AAA, AA and A. A point system determined state championships in the early going, with singles and doubles winners accumulating points based on victories that added up to the final team total. That format was eventually changed to the current team-oriented system that consists of three singles matches and two doubles pairings.

A fourth classification was added for the first time in 1979, with Westside of Augusta claiming the initial team prize in AAAA.

The boys field thus featured four state championship divisions on the team side every year from 1979-2000. A fifth competition was added on the AAAA level for the spring of 2001 tournament.

The girls state championship was added to the GHSA lineup in the spring of 1980, with four classifications making up the initial field. That format remained the same for 21 years through the end of the 2000 tournament. A fifth competition was also added on the AAAAA level for the girls starting in 2001.

The Georgia High School Association also briefly conducted a state singles tournament in conjunction with the team format. Championships were held in each of the four classifications for the boys and the girls the week after the state team tournament. That experiment lasted only four years from 1991-94.

DeKalb County boasts an impressive history in state tournament competition, having captured 21 championships combined between the boys and girls.

Local boys squads have won 16 team titles, while the girls own five team trophies. All but four of the state crowns were captured in a dominating run during the decade of the 1980s.

Legendary football coach **Wayman Creel** put together the first local tennis dynasty as the head skipper at Lakeside starting in the early 1970s.

Such super individual talents as **Rick Bodin**, **Grant Carlson**, **Paul Groth** (state singles champion, 1976) and **Kelly Thurman** (state singles champion, 1975) enabled the Viking boys machine to rank among the state elite throughout the decade. Groth and Thurman later played key roles for Georgia on the college level.

Lakeside strung together three consecutive state championships behind a deep and powerful lineup from 1980-82. **Chuck Sobers** and **Jim Duckworth** were the mainstays during that memorable run, dominating opponents both separately in singles and together in doubles. Sobers and Duckworth later signed scholarships and excelled collegiately for the University of Mississippi. **Mark Avedikian** and **Tommy Jones** also played for the Vikings initially on the high school level before transferring to other schools. Both also inked college deals after graduating from high school. **Ron Owen**, **Walter Koch** and **Jeff Duckworth** are three of many other players who played key roles for the Vikings.

Phil Lindsey took over the head coaching duties from Creel in the spring of 1984 and kept the Vikings in the thick of the region and state championship hunt several times over the next 16 years before leaving to take the Tucker head football post in 1999. Lindsey's 1997 team finished second to Marist at the state Class AAA tournament.

Henderson matched Lakeside as a top force during the late 1970s and early 1980s. Led by a colorful coach in **Dyke Goodin** and one of the most gifted players in DeKalb County history in **Allen Miller**, the Cougars claimed a share of state championships in 1978 and 1981 and just missed out in 1979 and 1980. Miller put on quite a show in leading the Henderson push and later helped the University of Georgia capture its first ever men's NCAA title in 1985.

Dunwoody served as a top force throughout the 1980s, winning four boys state Class AAAA championships. **Celeste Boemker** served as head coach for each of the victorious Wildcat squads in 1983, 1985, 1988 and 1989.

Coach **Bill Redford**'s Peachtree unit and coach **Debbie Boling**'s Redan squad shared the AAAA team crown with Dunwoody in 1983 and 1985 respectively.

Tucker emerged as the next local force in 1988, winning the first of three straight state Class AAA boys titles under the coaching direction of legendary football skipper **T. McFerrin**. McFerrin served as Tiger head coach in each of the championship seasons in 1988, 1989 and 1990. The brother duo of **Jeff Baker** and **Mike Baker** and **Scott Ambrose** led the way individually for a powerful Tucker squad that also lost to Marist in the AAA semifinals in 1991.

Chamblee added another notch to the list of local boys state champions with a dominating run during the 1998 season. **Sheila Wilder** served as head coach on a powerful squad that went a perfect 17-0 in capturing the AA state title.

Lakeside finally became the first state winner of the new decade, completing a super 16-1 campaign by edging Collins Hill 3-2 in the 2001 AAAAA championship match. Junior **Brandon Lee** won the deciding point in a three-set thriller at No. 1 singles. Former Oglethorpe player **Chris Smith** thus claimed his first state title as a head coach.

Dunwoody also boasts the most impressive history of state tournament success on the girls side, having snared consecutive AAAA championships under the coaching leadership of Boemker in 1980 and 1981. The Lady Wildcats also finished second to Walton in 1991, with **Wade Pearce** being the head coach for that edition.

Lindsey guided his first Lakeside girls squad to the top AAAA prize in 1984, while Druid Hills in AA in 1981 and Chamblee in AAAAA in 2017, 2018 and 2019 with a stellar cumulative record of 70-1 over those three years adding to the impressive state final triumphs.

2022 TENNIS YEAR IN REVIEW

Chamblee's girls made a serious run at a fourth state team crown in the last six years to lead the way among local tennis squads in the 2022 campaign.

Coach **Jennifer Tinnell**'s Lady Bulldogs advanced to the AAAAA state finals, knocking off Cartersville (3-0), Woodward Academy (3-1), Midtown (4-1) and Coffee County (3-0) along the way.

Region 5-AAAAA rival Northview awaited in the final, having already defeated Chamblee twice before in the regular season (4-1) and in the Region 5-AAAAA final (3-2).

The championship battle featured a neutral site in Rome but the same results in a championship victory by the Lady Titans in the final tally of 3-0.

Chamblee finished another memorable season with the final overall record of 16-7-1, having also lost only to the likes of Pace Academy (4-0), Marist (5-0), Lakeside (4-1) and Westminster (5-0)

The Lady Bulldogs scored impressive regular season triumphs over Norcross (3-2), GAC (4-1) and St. Pius (3-2) on the road to the state final.

Sophomore **Isabelle Coursey** (11-6) at No. 1, senior **Allison Lvovich** (14-5) at No. 2 and junior **Sophia Cheng** (11-2) at No. 3 provided a dominating trio of singles options.

The Lady Bulldogs also boasted a pair of strong tandems in doubles, where junior **Grace Seel** and sophomore **Ananya Jatar** finished 7-3 at No. 1 and senior **Genesis Pickens** and senior **Kennedy Talbert** posted an identical 7-3 mark at No. 2.

Dunwoody and Lakeside, meanwhile, shined brightest on the boys side, both advancing to the state quarterfinals in their respective AAAAAA and AAAAAA classifications.

Zoe Knight made her debut as the boys tennis coach at Dunwoody a stellar one, guiding the Wildcats to a Region 7-AAAAAA regular season crown with a perfect 6-0 mark.

The Wildcats then hosted Woodstock in the first round of the state Class AAAAAA playoffs, rolling from the start to a 4-1 triumph.

Dunwoody next took on North Paulding in the second round of state and had little trouble advancing from that matchup in a 3-0 blanking.

A powerful West Forsyth squad put an end to any state championship dreams in the third round, throwing a 3-0 shutout on the Wildcats.

Dunwoody closed out the year with a super 16-4 final overall record, losing only to such powerhouses as North Springs, Marist and Pace Academy during the regular season.

The Wildcats featured a veteran single lineup, with the brother tandem of seniors **Mark Romano** (6-14) at No. 1 and **Evan Romano** (4-8) at No. 3 singles forming plenty of experience around promising freshman **Bobby Kitchin** (9-13) at No. 2.

Seniors also ruled the day in doubles, where **Preston Files** and **Sam Woodrow** formed one team and posted an 11-13 record and **Jake Callahan** and **Andrew Munn** paired off for a 12-13 mark at the other tandem.

All four of those players thus joined Mark and Evan Romano to fill the veteran starting rotation with six seniors and one freshman.

Lakeside swept to regular season and tournament crowns in Region 4-AAAAAA, dropping only three individual matches to North Atlanta while posting a 7-0 record and earning a host role for the first round of state.

Coach **Toby Cortez** and the Vikings opened the state Class AAAAAA tournament with impressive triumphs over Richmond Hill (4-0) and Wheeler.

The Vikings, however, ran into a buzzsaw in the third round, dropping a 3-0 decision to Cambridge while finishing the year with a stellar 15-3 overall record.

Along with Cambridge, Lakeside also lost only to Paideia (3-2) and Marist (4-1) in the regular season and region and state tournaments.

The Vikings mixed and matched several players in their singles rotation, with sophomore **Sam Fourmier** (3-0), sophomore **Julian Santucci** (3-6) and freshman **Andy Moelich** (3-0) going 11-7 at the No. 1 position.

Moelich (5-1), sophomore **Tommy Ellett** (2-2) and junior **Luca Borisov** (1-4) played the majority of the matches at No. 2 singles, teaming up for an 8-7 record.

Moelich (3-2), sophomore **Marcus Beer** (3-1), Fourmier (3-0) and Borisov (2-0) handled the bulk of the action for an 11-3 record at No. 3 singles.

Junior brothers **Jay Jani** and **Shaan Jani** led the doubles rotation, going 4-1 at No. 1 and 4-0 at No. 2. Santucci and sophomore **Wynton Martin** also finished 4-0 at No. 1, while the pairing of junior **Derek Renero** and sophomore **Chase Rothberger** and the tandem of Renero and Beer posted team-best final 3-0 slates at No. 2 doubles.

Dunwoody's girls also made an impressive showing on the AAAAAA level, besting Cherokee (3-0) and Camden County (3-0) before falling to Lambert (3-1) in the quarterfinals and finishing with a strong 15-4-1 record.

Sophomores **Sophia Chiverton** (10-6) at No. 1 and **Ella Thomas** (6-3) at No. 2 led the way in singles, while junior **Ginny Duffy** and freshman **Mei Stallard** formed a stellar tandem with a 13-0 record at No. 2 doubles.

Lakeside's girls made it to the second round of state in AAAAAA on the way to posting a 10-7 final record, besting Richmond Hill (3-1) in the first round and losing to Pope (3-0) in the round of 16.

Freshman sensation **Nora Grady** led the way individually for the Lady Vikings, registering a perfect 6-0 mark at No. 1 singles and finishing 9-2 overall in singles.

Sophomore **Johanna Goebel** at No. 1 (4-7) and sophomore **Emily Ellingson** at No. 2 (0-7) completed the singles rotation, while seniors **Marianne Carman**, **Sarah Elder**, **Maggie Bell** and **Audrey Bender** led the way in doubles.

REGULAR SEASON AND TOURNAMENT INFORMATION

GENERAL INFORMATION:

A. Tennis is a team state championship sport for boys and girls that is based on Region play in all classifications.

Beginning and ending dates for practice and competition can be found at the front of this publication.

B. All tennis matches will be played according to tennis rules published by the U.S. Tennis Association (USTA) unless otherwise specified by the Georgia High School Association.

1. The rules of the USTA Handbook relating to lateness for a match will apply to GHSA matches.
2. There will be continuous play except that a GHSA certified coach from that school may talk to their player(s) as they change ends of the court after a game, but the player(s) must stay on the court.
3. In regular season play and in the Region tournament, the 8-game Pro Set format is allowed if both coaches are in agreement. 8-Game Pro Set: First player to win 8 games by a margin of 2 games (ie, 8-5, 8-6, 9-7) wins the set - if score gets to 8-8, the tie-breaker as outlined in this section is used.
4. Any GHSA tennis match that is interrupted, such as by weather or darkness, and can not be completed that day should be resumed (if it is to be made up) from the exact point of interruption at a future date agreed upon by the competing schools.

C. Teams are restricted to no more than eighteen (18) varsity play dates excluding Region and State tournaments. The 18 play dates are for the complete team (singles and doubles). There will be no singles tournaments allowed.

1. Each play date of an invitational tournament counts toward the maximum of 18 play dates.
2. No school shall enter any invitational tournament unless it has been approved by the GHSA Executive Director.
3. It is permissible for coaches to use "split squads" during the regular season. However, the use of split squads will count as two (2) of that school's maximum allowed play dates.
4. There shall be no interscholastic practices and/or scrimmages.

D. The format for all GHSA tennis matches during the regular season, region tournaments and state playoffs shall be three (3) singles matches and two (2) doubles matches played on composition (hard) surfaces unless the competing schools agree to play on a non-composition surface prior to the match.

With prior agreement of both coaches, JV squads may use a format of two (2) singles matches and one (1) doubles match.

NOTE: No GHSA match at any level may be played where there are fewer than three (3) points available and any pre-match forfeitures must take place at the lowest level. No. 1 singles and No. 1 doubles may never be forfeited before a match begins.

1. An individual player may play in either one (1) singles match or one (1) doubles match ONLY.
2. Substitution is not permitted once a match is engaged under USTA definition. If any injury occurs during play that prevents a player from completing the match, that player defaults and the opponent is awarded the victory.
3. Teams have the option to play a 10-point tiebreaker (see USTA rules for playing process) in lieu of a full third set during the regular-season and Region tournament by agreement of the two coaches during the regular-season and by a majority vote of the Region coaches in the Region tournament. Note: All State Playoff matches must be best of three full sets.
4. Teams may play up to three (3) matches in a day IF a 10-point tiebreaker is used in lieu of a full third set in all three matches.

E. 7-Point Tie-Breaker for Singles (Team A vs B).

1. This is used when the score is tied 6-6 (or 8-8 in Pro-Set) in any set (1st, 2nd, or 3rd).
2. Player A serves the first point from the right service area.
3. Player B serves the second and third points from the left and right service areas respectively.
4. Player A serves the fourth and fifth points - again alternating the service areas.
5. Player B serves the next two points and ends of the court are changed between these two points.
6. Player A serves the eighth and ninth points.
7. After this, the serve is alternated on every two points.
8. If the tie-breaker ends with a 6-6 score, the players change ends of the court and alternate serves until one player is ahead by two (2) points - which gives that player a set victory of 7-6. 9. Players switch ends of the court after every six (6) points and at the end of the tie-breaker.

F. 7-Point Tie-Breaker for Doubles (Team A & B vs C & D)

1. Player A serves the first point from the right service area.
2. Player C serves the second and third points - alternating the service areas.
3. Player B serves the fourth and fifth points.
4. Player D serves the sixth and seventh points, and ends of the court are changed between the points.
5. After this, play continues with the same service rotation until one team has either won seven (7) of the first twelve (12) points, or a team established a two-point margin after twelve (12) points have been played.

REGULAR SEASON AND TOURNAMENT INFORMATION

6. Teams change ends of court after every six (6) points and at the end of the tie-breaker.

G. Schools are encouraged, but not required, to enter team schedules, rosters and weekly game/meet results during the season on MaxPreps. This information will support statewide media, event programs, broadcasts partners and GHSA Region Standings. Teams are encouraged to maintain team/individual statistics on MaxPreps.

REGION COMPETITION:

A. Each Region will determine how it will choose its top four (4) teams.

1. The top 4 Region representatives shall be determined no later than April 13, 2023.

2. The top four Region teams must be submitted to the GHSA no later than 9:00 a.m., on April 14, 2023.

3. Five percent (5%) of the gross gate receipts (if admission is charged) will be sent to the GHSA, and then the Region will decide how to handle expenses and disbursements.

B. At the end of the regular season and prior to any post-season play, each coach will submit to the Region tournament director and enter electronically on the GHSA MIS web site an official playoff roster listing the singles players as Nos. 1, 2, and 3 and the doubles teams as Nos. 1 and 2, in proper order of ability (based on the integrity of the coach).

This roster will be the lineup used in ALL tournament play thereafter, unless an alternate is used under the restrictions listed below. NOTE: If no Region tournament is held, the official playoff roster must be entered electronically at the end of the regular season and prior to the start of the state tournament.

1. Stacking of one's lineup is strictly prohibited in any regular-season match, invitational tournament or state tournament match. An obvious attempt to stack a lineup (i.e., use a player or doubles team below their relative ability level on the team) may result in the immediate disqualification of the entire team.

(a) For each regular-season match, the coach will choose three players (A, B & C) to play singles and two pairs of players (D1 & D2) to play doubles that day. The best player of A, B and C must play the No. 1 position in singles and the weakest must play No. 3 singles. The best doubles team of D1 and D2 must play No. 1 doubles (Note: Points may only be forfeited beginning with the lower positions and working upward unless an injury or illness occurs after a match has begun). (b) It is not stacking to alternate from match to match during the regular season the positions of A and B, B and C, and even A and C if the players are of relatively equal ability. Likewise, D1 and D2 could alternate if these teams are of relatively equal ability.

(c) It is not stacking if players alternate from singles to doubles, and vice versa, from match to match during the regular season as long as the singles players being used that day are listed from No. 1 to No. 3 according to relative ability, and the best doubles team being used that day plays at No. 1 doubles. 2. Designate up to six (6) alternates on the official playoff roster to be used under the following conditions:

(a) Alternates should not be better in ability than ANY of the players listed on the playoff roster in the positions of Nos. 1, 2, or 3 singles OR Nos. 1 or 2 doubles.

(b) Alternates may be used in either singles or doubles competitions, but the same player may not be used for both in the same round of competition.

(c) Substitutions made after the official playoff roster has been submitted must be made at the lowest level of singles play with all others moving to the higher level of competition. In doubles competition, the coach has the option to place the alternate in the open slot or to place the alternate on the No. 2 doubles team and move a player from the No. 2 doubles team to the No. 1 doubles team, if the original vacancy is on the No. 1 team. A player may never be used in a position lower than his original position. NOTE: A substitution violation results in the loss of that line and not the forfeiture of the entire team match.

(d) If the original contestant(s) resumes play, everyone moves back to their original positions listed on the submitted playoff roster.

(e) A player listed as a singles player on the official playoff roster shall not switch over to doubles competitions in any later round, or vice-versa.

3. A serious injury, illness, suspension or other conflict MAY warrant a waiver of the anti-stacking restrictions listed above. Such waivers will be considered on a case-by-case basis upon receipt of proper documentation to the GHSA office, including a letter signed by the school's principal.

4. A school objecting to an opponent's lineup must provide documentation (newspaper articles, scorebooks, and written confirmation from other coaches) of any stacking violations.

STATE TOURNAMENT:

A. The State Tournament is considered a continuation of the Region Tournament.

1. Tournaments will be held for both boys teams and girls teams in each classification.

2. Trophies shall be presented to the champions and runners-up in each classification - both boys and girls.

3. In order to host a State Tournament match beyond the region level, the host school must have available a minimum of two (2) courts. Four (4) courts is preferable.

4. The First Four (4) Rounds of the State Tournament will take place on the "home" courts of the higher seeded teams with the following schedule: The First Round must be completed no later than April 20, 2023; the Second Round must be completed no later than April 26, 2023; the Quarterfinal Round must be completed no later than May 2, 2023; and the Semifinal Round must be completed no later than May 8, 2023. If the teams are equal seeds, a "universal" GHSA coin flip will determine the host school.
