CHAMBLEE RECLAIMS ALL-SPORTS CHAMPIONSHIP

A state championship in girls soccer served as the defining memory among many in guiding Chamblee to the DeKalb County All-Sports Trophy title for the 2022-23 school year. Chamblee claimed the All-Sports Trophy for the fourth time in school history and first time since the 2018-19 school year.

SOFTBALL HISTORY

DeKalb County served as one of the main forerunners in the introduction of fastpitch softball as a sanctioned sport on the high school level.

While the slowpitch version of the game has held state championships since 1981, fastpitch softball did not make its inaugural appearance until the fall of 1993.

Local schools dominated the field in that first season, as 18 of the 21 teams hailed from DeKalb County. Marist, Berkmar and Meadowcreek were the remaining three entrants.

Dunwoody put together an impressive run as the initial powerhouse in the sport, finishing either first or second in the state in each of the first four years.

Co-coaches **Lynn Maddox** and **Cheryl Finke** guided the Lady Wildcats to a super 101-15 record during that stretch. Dunwoody won at least 17 games every year from 1993-98.

The initial 1993 campaign featured a memorable battle between Dunwoody and Meadowcreek for what was then listed as the Metro Championships.

Dunwoody opened that tournament in dominating fashion, posting three straight shutout triumphs over Lithonia (9-0), Redan (6-0) and Berkmar (5-0) to advance to the championship round.

Matched up against Meadowcreek in best-of-three series, the Lady Wildcats fought to the very end before coming up just short in their pursuit of the first and only metro crown.

Dunwoody actually gained the early advantage by pulling out a 2-1 nailbiter in the first game of the showdown. Meadowcreek, however, bounced back to sweep the last two contests by the narrow respective margins of 12-9 and 2-1.

The Lady Wildcats used that heart-breaking defeat as inspiration in what would prove to be the first of their two state championship runs in 1994.

After posting a super 22-3 record in the regular season, Dunwoody rolled past Lassiter (3-1), Tucker (13-2), Brookwood (3-0) and Brookwood (7-3) again in a perfect 4-0 state march.

Overpowering sophomore southpaw **Adrienne Fortmann** capped a stellar 15-2 season on the mound, striking out six and allowing only two hits in picking up the pitching victory.

Junior shortstop **Sabrina Touchberry** (3-4, 2 RS), sophomore centerfielder **Amy Thompson** (2-4) and junior third baseman **Megan Galhouse** (2-4), meanwhile, shined brightest offensively for the Lady Wildcats.

Other key players for Dunwoody included junior catcher **Nancy Diamond**, sophomore pitcher-second baseman **Ashley Fawcett**, junior leftfielder **Shana Vidal**, freshman first baseman **Melissa Chastney** and freshman rightfielder **Jessica Tucker**.

Coach **Pat Floyd** and the Tucker Lady Tigers nearly joined Dunwoody in the championship round, dropping a 9-3 heartbreaker in 11 innings to Meadowcreek in the semifinals.

Freshman pitcher **Jill Wilkinson** (20-5), senior shortstop **Krissy Streid** and junior outfielder **Teresa Eubanks** led the charge for a Tucker squad that went 3-2 at state and finished 24-5 overall.

Redan also qualified for state in 1994, dropping two straight tough decisions to Brookwood (2-1) and Meadowcreek (2-0). Senior southpaw **Mandy Smart** was brilliant on the mound in defeat for the Lady Raiders.

Dunwoody nearly earned a second straight state championship in 1995, settling for runnerup honors after a stunning loss to Douglas County in the championship round.

The Lady Wildcats whipped Berkmar (9-1), Brookwood (7-3) and Parkview (8-1) to advance to the final, before dropping two consecutive decisions of 3-0 and 8-2 to Douglas County in finishing 29-5 overall.

A brilliant group of seniors, though, made up for that disappointment by climbing to the top of the state field for the second time in three years at the 1996 AAAA tournament.

Maddox was able to retire from the coaching ranks in style, as Dunwoody won three straight one-run decisions over Lassiter (2-1), Shaw (1-0) and Berkmar (3-2) and then easily rolled past Lassiter (6-0) again in the championship contest in wrapping up a memorable 27-4 season.

Fortmann struck out three and allowed only one hit in the final blitzing of Lassiter, while Thompson, Tucker and freshman shortstop **Nikki Reed** paced a balanced offense that received key contributions from several individuals.

Chamblee also earned a state berth on the AAA level in 1996, losing consecutive tough decisions to Columbus (5-4) and Douglas County (6-0) while getting eliminated in two games and finishing 19-10 overall for the season.

Tucker next ended a four-year dry spell for DeKalb County schools by advancing to the state Class AAAA tournament in 2001.

The Lady Tigers posted a 1-2 record at that battle on the way to finishing 31-4 overall. Super junior pitcher **Christy Wahl** established a new county strikeout record of 445 in leading a stellar campaign.

Martin Luther King Jr. garnered the next state berth for DeKalb County schools while advancing to the AAA tournament in 2004. Coach **Paris Burd**'s Lions went 1-2 there and finished 24-10 overall.

The 2017 season offered the biggest highlight in many years, as four DeKalb County squads advanced to the second round of the state tournament for the first time in county history.

Region 5-AAAAA led the way with three teams moving on, as league champion Arabia Mountain, No. 2 seed Chamblee and No. 3 entrant Miller Grove advanced and Dunwoody impressed in a first round sweep as well.

Both Arabia Mountain (23) and Chamblee (22) established school records for single season victories in 2017 to add to the long list of impressive achievements on the local level.

Chamblee made history again during the 2021 season, as coach **Alan Loper** guided the Lady Bulldogs to a new single season victory high while going 29-4 and advancing to the Elite 8 in Columbus for the first time.

Senior **Margaret Axelson** turned in a season for the ages in leading the way on the individual level for Chamblee, topping the county charts in RBIs (58), doubles (14), triples (7) and singles (29) on the offensive end and wins (15), strikeouts (135) and innings pitched (86) on the mound.

The Lady Bulldogs returned to the Elite 8 in Columbus for the second straight year in 2022, soaring to a 26-5 record and capturing the Region 4-AAAAA title along the way.

2022 SOFTBALL IN REVIEW

Chamblee's magical run through the state Class AAAAA softball tournament ended with a second straight trip to the Elite 8 in Columbus.

Alan Loper's eighth and final campaign as head coach saw the Lady Bulldogs storm to a perfect 10-0 showing in capturing the regular season Region 4-AAAAA crown, out-scoring Arabia Mountain (12-0 and 17-3), Decatur (14-1 and 5-3), Lithonia (20-0 and 15-0), Martin Luther King Jr. (16-0 and 15-0) and Tucker (15-0 and 18-1) by the lopsided cumulative margin of 148-8. That works out to around 15-1 per game.

The dominating regular season effort set Chamblee up to host a first round Super Regional field that included the likes of McIntosh, Union Grove and Ware County.

Loper's determined squad first drew McIntosh and jumped all over the Lady Chiefs from the start while rolling to a 10-2 triumph in five innings.

The Lady Bulldogs erupted for six runs in the first inning and never looked back, as sophomore **Kate Sarago** and junior **MacKenzie Cassidy** delivered key RBI singles to account for two of the runs.

Sarago finished 3-3 with three runs scored, two stolen bases and one RBI, while senior **Lily McCord** added two runs scored and two RBIs.

Chamblee followed up that first round romp with an equally impressive 9-1 decision over Union Grove in the second round.

Senior **Rachel Runsick**, Sarago and sophomore **Rachel Axelson** all finished 3-4 with one RBI at the plate in leading the victory, and junior **Shea Parker** also went 2-4 with an RBI.

McCord turned in another stellar performance on the pitching mound, striking out seven while allowing five hits and one walk in going the full six innings.

The Lady Bulldogs then closed up the Super Region triumph with a decisive 9-1 triumph over McIntosh in the final.

McCord stole the show in this outing, going 2-3 at the plate with three RBI on the offensive end and pitching the full five innings to the mound decision as well.

Chamblee thus advanced to the Elite 8 in Columbus for the second straight year, earning a first round date with traditional power Loganville.

The Lady Bulldogs played Loganville on an even level from the start, falling behind 5-0 before rallying for two runs in the top of the sixth inning and eventually falling by a 5-2 margin.

Chamblee next drew equally powerful Cambridge in the second round, coming up short at the plate while failing to score in dropping an 8-0 decision.

Several players turned in strong individual effort in helping the Lady Bulldogs finish 26-5 overall in the record category on the season.

Sarago (.542 BA; 40 RS; 27 RBI; 6 2B; 3 3B), Axelson (.444 BA; 17 RS; 16 RBI; 3 2B), Parker (.436 BA; 36 RS; 19 RBI; 7 2B; 3 3B), Runsick (.425 BA; 31 RS; 22 RBI; 2 HR; 6 2B; 3 3B), McCord (.370 BA; 31 RBI; 2 2B), senior **Parker Smith** (.343 BA; 17 RS; 10 RBI; 2 2B), junior **Julia Mansour** (.333 BA; 15 RBI; 13 RS; 3 2B) and senior **Savannah Russell** (.314 BA; 36 RS; 17 RBI; 3 2B) paced the offensive charge.

McCord, meanwhile, registered a brilliant final high school campaign on the pitching end, going 23-5 over 150 2/3 innings with a 1.72 ERA, 160 strikeouts and 45 walks.

Dunwoody in AAAAAA, Arabia Mountain in AAAAA, Tucker in AAAAA, Southwest DeKalb in AAAA, Miller Grove in AAAA, Cedar Grove in AAA and Columbia in AA joined Chamblee as state tournament qualifiers.

Coach **Jake Hill's** Dunwoody Lady Wildcats finished with the No. 3 seed out of Region 4-AAAAAA, posting a 7-5 record in league action in trailing only North Atlanta and Marist.

Dunwoody took care of Woodward Academy in the first round of the AAAAAA state tournament, pulling out a tight thriller by a 6-4 margin.

The Lady Wildcats then dropped consecutive decisions to South Effingham (13-0) and Tift County (14-13) in falling to a final record of 13-18.

Arabia Mountain entered the state Class AAAAA tournament as the No. 3 seed behind Chamblee and Decatur following a 6-4 final league showing.

Coach **Eric Hoxie's** Lady Rams faced a difficult opening assignment in Northside Columbus, coming up on the short end of a 13-1 decision.

Arabia Mountain then fell by an 8-0 margin to Jones County in the second round, finishing the year with an even final overall record of 9-9.

Tucker also advanced to the AAAAA tournament as the No. 4 seed out of Region 4-AAAAA, tallying a 4-6 league mark under the direction of head coach **Johnathan Farley**.

The Lady Tigers lost consecutive decisions to Harris County (16-0) and Statesboro (17-1) in finishing the season with a 5-15 final overall mark.

Southwest DeKalb secured the No. 3 seed out of Region 6AAAA, defeating Druid Hills (13-12) and Miller Grove (12-8) at the region tournament to move up the third spot in the final league standings.

Coach **Jennifer Adams** saw her Lady Panthers drop consecutive state outings to Lovett (12-0) and Sonorville (19-3) in AAAA state tournament action in finishing the year with a 10-13 final mark.

REGULAR SEASON AND TOURNAMENT INFORMATION

GENERAL INFORMATION:

A. Fast Pitch Softball is a state championship event organized on a Region basis in all seven classifications. Beginning and ending dates for practice and competition can be found at the front of this publication.

B. All softball games will be played by the rules as published by the National Federation of State High School Associations.

C. The maximum number of softball games allowed (not including state tournament games) shall be: thirty (30) games either head-to-head competition or in invitational or region tournaments.

1. Region tournaments shall be structured so that no school will play more than eight (8) games in that tournament.
2. Schools may not enter any softball tournament other than the region tournament or state elimination series unless such tournament has been approved by the GHSA Executive Director.
3. Sub-varsity teams are allowed to play 70 percent of their respective varsity team's regular season games. Sub-varsity teams shall not schedule a tournament after they have reached their 70 percent game restriction.
4. Contracts are required for all GHSA member school fastpitch softball games, including invitational tournaments.

D. All varsity softball games shall be played with officially-dressed officials who are registered under the GHSA plan for the registration of officials. The assignment of officials for regular-season games, invitational tournaments, and sub-region and region tournaments will be made by the GHSA office.

1. The GHSA will assign one or more associations to each school for their games.
2. The school and the local association(s) will sign a contract for the games that are assigned.

E. The use of WBGT for ALL Fastpitch Softball Contests is mandated as follows:

1. WBGT must be measured 15 minutes prior to start of contest, coaches and umpires must be notified.
2. If WBGT is equal or above 86.0 F, an ice immersion tub must be present and ready for use.
3. If WBGT is equal or above 88.0 F, Umpires will take a 3-minute hydration break at the beginning and mid-point of inning 3 and continuing until the conclusion of the game.

F. The following rule "State Adoptions" have been approved for GHSA play in softball:

1. The game will end when:
 - (a) a team has completed three turns at bat and is fifteen (15) runs behind.
 - (b) a team has completed four turns at bat and is twelve (12) runs behind.
 - (c) a team has completed five or more turns at bat and is eight (8) runs behind.
2. The courtesy runner rule has been adopted. NOTE: Participation as a courtesy runner does not constitute entry into the game, and does not count as a game played.
3. The use of a double first base is recommended.
4. The suspended game rule will be used.
 - (a) When a game is stopped before it becomes a legal game, it is considered to be "no contest" and any replay will begin from the first inning.
 - (b) When a game is stopped after it becomes a legal game and a winner can be determined, the game is completed.
 - (c) When a game is stopped after it becomes a legal game and a winner can not be determined, any replay will begin from the point of interruption.
 - (d) Exception: If a State Tournament game is suspended at any point, it shall resume from the point of interruption on the next available date. If that date can not be agreed upon by the competing schools, the GHSA Executive Director shall determine the playing date.
5. Termination of the game due to weather, unplayable conditions, or mechanical malfunctions:
 - (a) The umpires may halt play for up to two (2) hours when conditions do not allow play to continue.
 1. The two-hour interruption(s) is cumulative.
 2. The game must be terminated when the two-hour time period has elapsed. If the first game of a doubleheader is terminated, the second game will be postponed.
 3. The two-hour period does not include time needed to prepare the field for the resumption of play.
 - (b) Umpires must wait for at least 30 minutes before terminating a game for unplayable field conditions.
6. In any softball game, if a team does not show up within 30 minutes of the scheduled game time, a forfeit shall be declared unless the delay is unavoidable and the visiting team notifies the home team. In emergency situations, the game may be started late, or may be rescheduled.
7. In order to be used, the tie-breaker procedure shall be agreed upon by both teams during the pregame meeting with the umpires. If implemented, the procedure shall begin in the 10th inning (and any subsequent half-inning). Exception: In Invitational Tournament games with a "time limit" policy, the tie-breaker procedure would start in the subsequent inning after time had expired. If not agreed upon, games may end in a tie after seven (7) full innings, or after time had expired during invitational tournament games.
8. Only game-essential personnel are permitted within the confines of the team's dugout and shall be held to the same level of accountability as the coaching staff and players.

REGULAR SEASON AND TOURNAMENT INFORMATION

9. Sub-varsity games may have a time limit instead of playing seven innings as long as the guidelines are agreed upon before the start of the game.
 10. Varsity games played in invitational tournaments may have time limits as follows:
 - (a) No game may be less than five innings regardless of the time limit (4.5 innings if home team is ahead.)
 - (b) No time limit may be less than 90 minutes.
 11. Same-day multiple games, using the same umpires, shall receive the doubleheader game fee listed in the Appendix "F" Game Fee Chart.
 12. Host schools are required to post the current USA SOFTBALL list of "Non-Approved" bats in both dugouts during GHSA sanctioned games.
- G. Teams may have spring try-outs that are limited to a maximum of five consecutive school days between May 1 and the last day students are in school. Students must be academically eligible and enrolled at the school they are trying out for, or be an 8th grader at a feeder school for that school. Students currently in the 7th grade (rising 8th graders) may not participate in spring tryouts.
- H. Schools must enter team schedules, rosters and weekly game/meet results during the season on MaxPreps and be responsible for updates as needed. This information will support statewide media, event programs, broadcasts partners and GHSA Region Standings. Teams are encouraged to maintain team/individual statistics on MaxPreps.

FAST PITCH REGION TOURNAMENTS:

- A. The dates, times and sites will be determined by each Region and must be submitted to the Region Secretary.
- B. Each Region in All Classes will determine its top four (4) teams advancing to the Super Regionals no later than October 12, 2023, with the top four teams advancing to the First Round of the state playoffs. Teams advancing to the Super Regionals must be submitted in the MIS system no later than 9:00 a.m., on October 13, 2023.
- C. Region post-season games (play-in games, sub-region games, region tournament games) must have a minimum of two (2) games played on each field, each day, with the exception of a championship game.

FAST PITCH STATE TOURNAMENT:

- A. The first two rounds of the State Tournament will be played as a "Super Regional."
 1. The No. 1 seed in each 4-team pod in the bracket will host a double-elimination tournament in according to the seeding on the official GHSA playoff brackets.
 - (a) Classes A (Div. 2), 3A, 5A & 7A play their Super Regionals on Oct. 16-17.
 - (b) Classes A (Div. 1), 2A, 4A & 6A play their Super Regionals on Oct. 18-19.
 2. The higher-seeded team in each Super Regional game will be the designated "home" team.
 3. One team will advance from each Super Regional to a pre-designated placement in the Elite Eight bracket in Columbus, Georgia (see Appendix B).
- B. The Elite Eight of the State Tournament will be a double-elimination tournament held in Columbus, Georgia on October 25-28, 2023.

C. FINANCES:

1. Admission for the Super Regional events is \$12.00 per day or \$20.00 for a two-day pass. Admission for the Elite Eight is as follows:
 - (a) Single day admission is \$15.00.
 - (b) Four-day admission is \$45.00. NOTE: All Super Regional and Elite Eight admission fees MUST be purchased through GoFan.
2. The GHSA will receive 12% of the gross gate receipts at all state playoff games. If schools are not able to cover the required costs with gate receipts, this fee will be waived if validated by the GHSA office.
3. In the Super Regionals, the umpires will be paid out of gross receipts (Note: If the gross receipts are not sufficient to pay the umpires, the host school will pay that cost.)
4. The visiting teams shall be paid \$.80 per mile (one way) for travel.
5. During the Super Regionals and Elite Eight, each team is allowed free admission for a maximum of 25 players and team essential personnel. Schools desiring more than this number must pay the admission price or submit names on the "Excess Team Entry Form." Coaches will be admitted with their GHSA coaching passes.
6. During the Super Regions, teams are responsible for their own travel and housing expenses, but housing will be arranged by the Columbus Sports Council for the Elite Eight Tournament in Columbus. D. All umpires will be assigned by the GHSA.
- E. Times posted with the brackets are approximate. Teams should be ready to take the field for play at the time indicated for each game.
