COACHING LEGEND RANG UP MULTIPLE TITLES

A multiple county and state team champion at two DeKalb County schools, **Kent Sanderson's** coaching resume in cross country had few equals in his long and distinguished career.

Sanderson first made his mark at old Gordon High School in a golden run over most of the decade of the 1980s.

The Generals literally ran over their opposition, registering five straight boys team state triumphs in 1981, 1982, 1983, 1984 and 1985.

Throw in three more county team crowns in 1982, 1983 and 1984, and Gordon's boys picked up an impressive total of eight combined overall state and county crowns under Sanderson.

Sanderson also fielded several powerhouse girls teams during his tenure at Gordon, walking away with top prizes at state in 1982 and county in 1982 and 1983.

A move to Shamrock led to county boys triumphs in 1987, 1988 and 1989 and County girls victories in 1989, 1990 and 1991.

CHAMBLEE ROLLS TO IMPRESSIVE ALL-SPORTS TRIUMPH

A state championship in girls soccer served as the defining memory among many in guiding Chamblee to the DeKalb County All-Sports Trophy title for the 2022-23 school year.

Chamblee claimed the All-Sports Trophy for the fourth time in school history and first time since the 2018-19 school year.

CROSS COUNTRY HISTORY

DeKalb County boasts a long and proud history in the sport of cross country, ranking among the state elite almost from the inception of the sport on the high school level 66 years ago.

State competition was initiated on an Open Event level only for the boys starting in the fall of 1953, with North Fulton capturing team honors for the first of two straight years.

The Open Event classification continued through 1964, as Druid Hills claimed consecutive team titles in 1957 and 1958 to lead the way among local entrants.

A new format was instituted in 1965, featuring two divisions. That field was then expanded to three divisions starting in 1967 and running through the 1969 campaign.

DeKalb County realized two more championships in this period, as Tucker topped the Division II field in 1965 and Lakeside began a string of nearly a decade of domination by capturing the Division I top prize in 1969.

The Georgia High School Association finally officially sanctioned cross country as a state championship sport in 1970, and DeKalb County immediately flexed its muscles in that first season.

Lakeside's boys won the first of four state Class AAA crowns over a six-year period that fall, while Shamrock also outlasted the field to snare top honors on the AA level.

Local schools soared to two more state championships two years later in 1972, with Lakeside again sitting at the top of the AAA field and Lithonia grabbing the top prize in a combined A and B classification draw.

Walker was runner-up to Lakeside in the AAA battle in 1972, as all-star senior **Ricky Watson** won the second of his two consecutive individual state trophies.

Longtime head coach **Eddie Roberts** would go on to guide Lakeside to two more AAA titles in 1973 and 1975, with only Dunwoody preventing a four-peat while taking the top AAA finish in 1974.

Tony Dipaola and **Mark Thompson** served as two of many individual driving forces during this period of Viking domination in the early 1970s.

Several new faces began popping up on the state championship trophy list starting in 1977, as Avondale, behind two-time winner **Chase Van Valkenburg**, walked away with its lone top prize as the AA boy's winner that fall.

Towers joined Lakeside, Lithonia, Dunwoody and Avondale on the state title list by finishing at the top of the AAA draw for the first and only time in 1980.

The most dominating local state run of all, however, began in the fall of 1981, with Gordon snaring the AAA crown for the first of what would eventually prove to be five consecutive years through the 1985 campaign.

Chamblee, meanwhile, became DeKalb County's seventh boy's state champion in 1986, walking away with the AAA title while ending Gordon's rule at five years.

Gordon's **James Flack**, Chamblee's **Chad Newton** and Lakeside's **Scott Griffith** ranked among many other individual standouts during that period in helping their respective teams push for state honors.

Lakeside nearly returned to the top of the state field for the first time in 25 years in 2000, finishing only two points behind Collins Hill in a brilliant runner-up showing in the AAAAAA race.

All-world junior **Joe Thorne**, however, did leave little doubt on the individual side, easily storming to the line first in a blistering time of 15:40.35. Thorne repeated as state champion in 2001, winning in an equally sizzling 15:49.

Southwest DeKalb senior **Phillip Burks** captured the 2005 AAAAA boy's battle in the splendid time of 16:21, while senior **Nabil Hamid** of Druid Hills grabbed the AAA title in 2008 in 15:50 and junior **Leonel Ayala** of Cross Keys snared the AA crown in 2009 in 16:22 and 2010 in 16:18.

Clarkston added to the team championship list with three straight victorious efforts in AAAAA in 2014, 2015 and 2016, while Lakeside junior **Davis Stockwell** captured the boys AAAAAA individual state crown in 16:34 in 2014.

The Georgia High School Association first officially sanctioned the girls state meet in 1975, with North Cobb (AAA, AA) and Berry Academy (A, B) snaring the top team prizes in that initial battle.

Peachtree gave DeKalb County its first girl's state title in the fall of 1979, outlasting a loaded field to capture top honors on the AAAA level.

Chamblee joined the championship parade two years later, racing to the head of the pack in snaring the AAA team prize in 1981.

Gordon and Dunwoody produced DeKalb County's fourth and fifth girl's state title with victorious efforts in the AAA race in 1982 and AAAAAA battle in 2012 respectively. Dunwoody netted two more crowns in AAAAA in 2014 and 2015.

Shamrock's **Celeste Baker**, Tucker's **Tracey Harrell**, Chamblee's **Stacie Reich**, **Alison Danford** and **Emily Reese**, Dunwoody's **Jeanne Hendrickson** and Lakeside's **Rebecca Mullen** have served as some of the top individual stars. Reese won her fourth straight individual state title in 2007, snaring the AAA prize in 17:56. Lakeside's **Meghan Wetterhall** won the AAAA race with a super 19:12 clocking in 2008. Dunwoody's **Alex Cameron** prevailed in 19:50 on the AAAAA level in 2012. Younger sister **Samantha Cameron** added a second state championship to the family name, taking AAAAA honors for the Lady Wildcats with a 20:26 clocking in 2015.

2022 CROSS COUNTRY SEASON IN REVIEW

Clarkston's boys inched closer to a fourth state championship in the last nine years to serve as the top highlight among many for DeKalb County cross country runners in 2022.

Jennifer Rickard and **Cardinal Clarke** skippered the Angoras to an impressive sixth county team triumph in the last 10 years and equally strong performances of second behind Westminster at the Region 6-AAAA meet and third behind Westminster and Starr's Mill at the state Class AAAA showdown.

The Angoras tallied 138 points to the 54 of Westminster and 66 of Starr's Mill at state, nearly placing all seven entrants among the top 50.

Sophomore **Abenezer Woellore** took center stage on the individual side, rumbling to a stellar showing of eighth at state (16:57).

Six of the seven runners that competed for Clarkston at state were underclassmen, including a particularly loaded sophomore class of five.

Along with Woellore, the sophomore class at the state meet consisted of **Yoseph Beserat** (21st; 17:45), **Claude Tusiime** (27th; 18:04), **Mengesha Alebachew** (48th; 18:40) and **Abdul Mahamat** (51st; 18:42).

Senior **Dejene Abatie** and junior **Jean Paul Irasubiza** also made the state trip to Carrollton, finishing 36th (18:17) and 46th (18:36) respectively.

The Angoras had earlier rolled to a dominating victory at the county meet, scoring 31 points to easily out-distance Chamblee (59), Dunwoody (73) and Druid Hills (93) at the top of the leaderboard.

Woellore took home first place on the individual side at county, crossing the finish line at Druid Hills Middle School in a blistering time of 16:57.

Beserat (5th; 17:35), Tusiime (6th; 17:42), Alebachew (9th; 17:58) and Abatie (10th; 18:00) also cracked the top 10, while Mahamat and Irasubiza placed 14th (18:39) and 17th (18:46) respectively.

Chamblee was led by the top five individual county meet finishes of senior **William Elder** (3rd; 17:17) and junior **Matthew Coates** (4th; 17:27).

Druid Hills also had two top 10 individual finishers in juniors **Owen Blount** (2nd; 17:08) and **Ethan Berryman** (7th; 17:49), while Dunwoody added senior **Mark Westrick** to the leading cast with an eighth place timing of 17:54.

Super junior **Claire Shelton** paced the Dunwoody girls to the 10th county team triumph in school history, tallying 31 points to best the strong challenges of Lakeside (49) and Chamblee (54).

Shelton picked up her second individual county gold medal, flying to the finish first in the clocking of 20:34.

Chamblee sophomore **Tally Pendleton** (2nd; 20:52), Dunwoody sophomore **Ronnie Amrani** (3rd; 21:34) and Lakeside seniors **Ellie Skelton** (4th; 21:41) and **Tristan Linscott** (5th; 21:54) rounded out the top five.

Dunwoody also received top 10 individual showings from senior Emma Parker (6th; 21:59) and **Chloe Warren** (10th; 22:31) in claiming the county team prize for the seventh time in the last 11 years.

Other scorers for the Lady Wildcats were sophomore **Jenna McJunkin** (11th; 22:48), **Bobbi Allen** (13th; 23:24) and senior **Mary McLoughlin** (18th; 24:04).

After finishing second as a team for the seventh time in the last 10 years, Lakeside also placed senior **Haley Davis** (8th; 22:11), **Libby Rountree** (12th; 23:10), junior **Shreya Chatterjee** (20th; 24:32), senior **Avery Ortlund** (21st; 24:48) and junior **Savannah Spires** (22nd; 24:48) in the final top 25.

Chamblee senior **Reagan Kuehne** (7th; 22:05) and freshman **India Shuler** of Druid Hills (9th; 22:20) also cracked the individual top 10 for girls at the county meet.

REGULAR SEASON AND TOURNAMENT INFORMATION

GENERAL INFORMATION:

- A. Cross Country is a team championship sport for boys and girls that is held on a Region basis for ALL classes.
- B. The distance for both boys and girls Cross Country will be approximately three (3) miles or five (5) kilometers.
- C. All GHSA Cross Country meets will be run in accordance with the rules as published in the National Federation Track and Field and Cross Country Rule Book with any exceptions as may be found in this section.
- D. The maximum number of competition dates in Cross Country shall be 10, exclusive of region and state competitions.
 - 1. It is permissible for coaches to use “split squads” during the regular season. However, the use of split squads will count as two (2) of that school’s maximum allowed competitions.
 - 2. Any meets involving eight (8) or more schools must be approved by the GHSA Executive Director in accordance with the process found in By-Law 2.64.
 - 3. No individual athlete may compete in more than one (1) race per day.
- E. All competitors shall have legal uniforms in compliance with GHSA and NFHS uniform rules.
- F. Beginning and ending dates for practice and competition can be found at the front of this publication.
 - 1. There will be no interscholastic practices in Cross Country.
 - 2. Athletes may run in non-GHSA events as long as they do not represent their school, do not wear the school uniform, and are not coached at the event by their high school coach (“unattached runner”).
 - 3. Communication through electronic devices is not allowed during competition.
 - 4. The State Championship course is off limits beginning August 1 of each year until all state championships are concluded (unless a GHSA sanctioned/scheduled meet is run during the regular season on the course and a school participates in the event). Course preview and practice times for all state championship participants are TBD and will be posted on the GHSA web site at a later date.

REGION COMPETITION:

- A. The initial team roster of twelve (12) runners must be submitted electronically no later than October 28, 2023. Changes to the roster may be made until the deadline established by each region.
 - 1. Coaches are to list runners in priority order: the top seven (7), then the selected five (5) alternates.
 - 2. Region Secretaries may download their region’s schools’ rosters after this submission.
- B. 1. Four (4) teams in each Region (classes A through 7A) will advance to the State Meet.
 - a. All qualifiers must be determined by Saturday, October 28, 2023 (All Classes).
 - b. Region qualifiers must be sent by electronic submission to the GHSA Office within 48 hours of the completion of the Region Meet; but not later than 9:00 a.m., on Monday, October 30, 2022.
- 2. The first six (6) individual finishers from each region in ALL classes will qualify for the State Meet regardless of whether they are a member of a qualifying team.
- C. Cross Country rosters should list twelve (12) contestants. No replacements may be made in the list submitted to the Region Meet Director. Any seven (7) of the twelve (12) may run in the Region or State.

STATE MEET:

- A. The State Cross Country Meet for all classifications will be held at Carrollton High School on the dates indicated on the Beginning and Ending Dates table at the front of this publication. The running order may be found on the Cross Country page of the GHSA web site (www.ghsa.net).
 - 1. There will be an admission fee posted on the GHSA web site for all spectators.
 - 2. The Meet Director will be Craig Musselwhite, 678-910-3022.
 - 3. Awards will be presented at the conclusion of each classification.
- B. A minimum of five (5) and a maximum of seven (7) runners will be allowed free admission for each team that qualified. Coaches will be admitted on their GHSA coaching passes.
 - 1. The first five (5) finishers for each team will count for the total team score.
 - 2. Each team must begin and end the competition with a minimum of five (5) runners. If, for any reason, a qualifying team does not have five (5) runners, that team will not be allowed to compete in the State Meet.
 - 3. Each member of a qualifying team, as well as individual qualifiers from each region, is considered to be in contention for individual honors.
