## VOLLEYBALL HISTORY

Volleyball returned to DeKalb County high schools for the first time in nearly two decades during the fall of 2000 campaign.

Boys and girls on the local level both once played volleyball on a yearly basis from the late 1960s until the sport was finally dropped following the 1980 season.

Led by private school powers Westminster, Marist and Woodward Academy, volleyball remained alive as primarily a metro Atlanta push through the rest of the 1980s and the entire 1990s.

Enthusiasm in the sport continued to pick up steam behind strong showings by the USA men and women on the Olympic and international scenes. The 1996 Summer Olympics in Atlanta, in particular, seemed to generate increased excitement and participation in volleyball.

Cobb County has ranked as the most successful among public schools from the start in the battle for volleyball supremacy. Walton, Sprayberry and Lassiter stand at the top of this crowded list.

Volleyball, however, remains a work in progress outside of the metro Atlanta area. Savannah is one strong exception to this case, with Savannah Christian and Savannah Country Day heading up a long list of eligible and talented entrants.

Athens, Augusta, Brunswick, Carrollton, Cartersville, Dallas, Dalton, Fairburn, Forsyth, Gainesville, Loganville, Monroe, Rome and Villa Rica are among the other areas that have seen dramatic growth among both the public and private school participation in volleyball over the last five years.

The Georgia High School Association (GHSA) has taken notice of this increased enthusiasm, sanctioning the state tournament for the first time beginning in the 1993 season.

Marist, Woodward Academy and Westminster took turns dominating the state field in an open event for all classifications from 1993-98.

Coach **Sergio Stadler**'s Marist machine claimed a pair of state titles during this period, running the table in both 1994 and 1997. Woodward Academy matched that total with victorious efforts in both 1993 and 1996, while Westminster walked away with the top prize in 1995.

The state championship hunt was opened considerably with the decision to divide the field up into classifications starting in 1998.

Two state trophies were thus up for grabs in both 1998 and 1999, with Walton and Marist claiming consecutive triumphs in AAAA and AAA respectively in those years.

The field was divided even more in the fall of 2000. Four separate prizes were handed out in AAAAA, AAAA, AAA and AA/A.

Walton (AAAAA), Marist (AAAA), Westminster (AAA) and Savannah Country Day (AA/A) earned state crowns in those respective divisions.

Lakeside (7AAAAA) and Avondale (4AAA) shined brightest in volleyball's return to DeKalb County in 2000, claiming area tournament titles in their respective leagues. Cross Keys also earned a sectional tournament berth as the runnerup to Avondale in 4AAA.

Lakeside repeated as Area 7AAAAA champion in 2001, and Redan (7AAAAA), Columbia (1AAAA) and Druid Hills (1AAA) also snared state sectional tournament berths after placing second in their respective area clashes.

A new chapter was added in 2002, as Lakeside became the first DeKalb County school to qualify for the state tournament in AAAAA. Druid Hills joined Lakeside as area champions.

Chamblee, meanwhile, established a new county victory standard during the 2005 campaign, soaring to a stellar 56-8 showing that included a berth in the state Class AAAA Final Four.

Lakeside added another memorable performance to the local list of highlights in 2012, soaring all the way to the state Class AAAAA tournament semifinals on the way to posting a stellar 29-7 final overall record under coach **Angela Thompson**.

Dunwoody joined the select group of DeKalb County squads to shine in the state tournament during the 2013 season, advancing to the AAAAA semifinals behind victories over Warner Robins, Hiram and Apalachee. Coach **Doug Friedlander**'s Lady Wildcats posted a 29-14 final record.

The Lady Wildcats advanced to the AAAAA semifinals again in 2014 and 2015, finishing 43-5 and 37-15 respectively during those memorable campaigns.

## 2022 VOLLEYBALL IN REVIEW

Same song with a slightly altered ending characterized the DeKalb County results on the volleyball court during the 2022 campaign a year ago.

Cedar Grove and Towers earned state tournament berths for only the second time in school history in leading the way among local entrants.

Six other DeKalb County teams also advanced to the annual state showdown, led by the second round tandem Chamblee and Dunwoody.

Coach **Cali Dennison**'s Cedar Grove Lady Saints secured a rare state tournament berth out of Area 5-AAA, advancing to the big dance for the first time since the 2009 squad reached state.

Cedar Grove faced a tough road challenge in the first round, falling by a 3-0 margin to Bremen in finishing the year with a 1-21 record.

Coach **Keith Puckett** and the Towers Lady Titans followed a similar Cinderella story as Cedar Grove, reaching state for the second time ever.

The Lady Titans faced a difficult first round draw at state as well, traveling to North Cobb Christian and losing by a 3-0 tally in posting a 12-19 final overall slate.

Seniors **Iteria Davis** (11 blocks; 9 aces; 7 kills) and **Shaniyah Lee** (28 aces) served as two of the individual standouts for Towers.

Coach **Lorri Reynolds** guided her Chamblee Lady Bulldogs to a split decision at the state Class AAAA tournament, besting Northgate by a 3-1 margin in the first round before dropping a heart-breaking 3-2 decision to Statesboro in the round of 16 and posting a 22-17 final overall record.

Several players turned in banner individual seasons for Chamblee, led by sophomore **Natalie Tsai** (632 assists; 199 digs; 198 aces; 84 kills; 28 blocks), senior **Naa Adua Annan** (175 kills; 132 digs; 60 aces), sophomore **McKenna Smith** (156 kills; 146 digs; 37 aces; 1 blocks), senior **Layla Burrell** (191 kills; 76 blocks; 48 aces; 45 digs) and freshman **Maggie Meeks** (84 kills).

Neighborhood rival Dunwoody joined Chamblee as the second DeKalb qualifier to reach the second round, advancing out of a loaded Region 4-AAAAAA field that also included St. Pius, Marist, Riverwood, Lakeside and North Atlanta.

Coach **Julie Gartner**'s Lady Wildcats rolled past Rockdale County by a 25-7, 25-8 and 25-9 margin in the first round and lost a 3-1 decision to Houston County in the second round by the respective scores of 25-16, 20-25, 25-12 and 25-22 on the way to posting a county-best final overall record of 27-11.

Dunwoody's top individual weapons included the likes of senior **Morgan Speice** (801 assists; 202 digs; 52 aces; 26 kills; 17 blocks); senior **Caroline Vanke** (426 kills; 233 digs; 46 aces; 23 blocks; 16 assists); senior **Jazlyn Daughtry** (271 kills; 228 digs; 50 aces; 25 blocks) and senior **Claire Warren** (328 digs; 60 assists; 42 aces).

Southwest DeKalb returned to the state playoffs for the eighth time in the last nine years, earning a trip out of Region 6-AAAA.

Coach **Kristina Parrish**'s Lady Panthers came up on the short end of a 3-0 decision in the first round, falling by the respective scores of 25-9, 25-8 and 25-9 to eventual state runner-up Lovett.

Individual standouts for Southwest DeKalb included junior **Toni Bryant** (48 kills; 38 aces); senior **Kyla Mark** (32 kills; 19 blocks); junior **Zayna Middlebrooks** (79 kills; 49 aces; 26 blocks); senior **Sanai Shaw** (97 assists; 46 aces; 32 kills; 17 digs); senior **Michaela Wilson** (51 aces; 30 digs) and junior **Genesis Monroe** (25 kills; 22 aces).

Stephenson joined Southwest DeKalb as a state qualifier out of Region 6-AAAA; drawing eventual state champion Pace Academy on the road in the first round.

Coach **Clinnette Moon**'s Lady Jaguars put up a solid fight before dropping a 25-8, 25-8 and 25-4 decision and posting a strong 18-7 final overall record.

Several players shined on the individual level for Stephenson, paced by senior **Jamaya Allen** (78 digs; 42 aces; 39 kills); junior **Morgan Sheppard** (81 assists; 40 digs; 29 aces; 16 kills); junior **Jasmine White** (34 blocks; 12 kills); junior **Kiersten Wright** (27 kills; 25 blocks); junior **Mya Smoot** (19 kills; 17 aces); sophomore **Addison Holloway** (126 digs; 18 aces) and freshman **Natalie Mahoney** (54 digs; 31 aces).

Tucker advanced to state out of Region 4-AAAAAA, drawing a difficult opening round road trip to traditional power McIntosh.

Coach **Maureen Jekielek**'s Lady Tigers dropped a 3-0 decision in the long run, losing by the respective scores of 25-5, 25-7 and 25-6 while posting a 13-13 final overall mark.

Individual leaders for Tucker included junior **Gabriele Cole** (56 aces; 33 assists; 22 kills); senior **Kyleen Drowns** (26 assists; 14 aces); junior **Heather Eggleston** (19 aces; 18 kills); senior **Alanna Innis** (49 aces; 15 kills); junior **Kristan Simmons** (59 aces; 34 kills; 24 blocks) and sophomore **Avari Terrell** (16 blocks; 13 aces).

Arabia Mountain earned a seventh consecutive trip to the state playoffs under the guidance of long-time head coach **Bruce Pfleger**.

The Lady Rams drew a road trip to Harris County in the first round, dropping a 3-0 decision by the respective scores of 25-5, 25-11 and 25-9 in falling to a 15-16-1 final record.

Sophomore **Reagan Mann** (313 assists; 92 digs; 83 aces; 46 kills; 11 blocks); sophomore **Jordan Mann** (190 kills; 82 digs; 51 aces; 18 assists); sophomore **Haley Martin** (89 digs; 63 kills; 48 aces); junior **Rhianna Minott** (34 assists; 15 aces; 12 digs); junior **Arielle Flint** (43 kills; 22 aces; 13 blocks) and sophomore **Athalia Henderson** (22 kills; 11 aces; 11 digs) served as some of the main top individual stars for Arabia Mountain.
