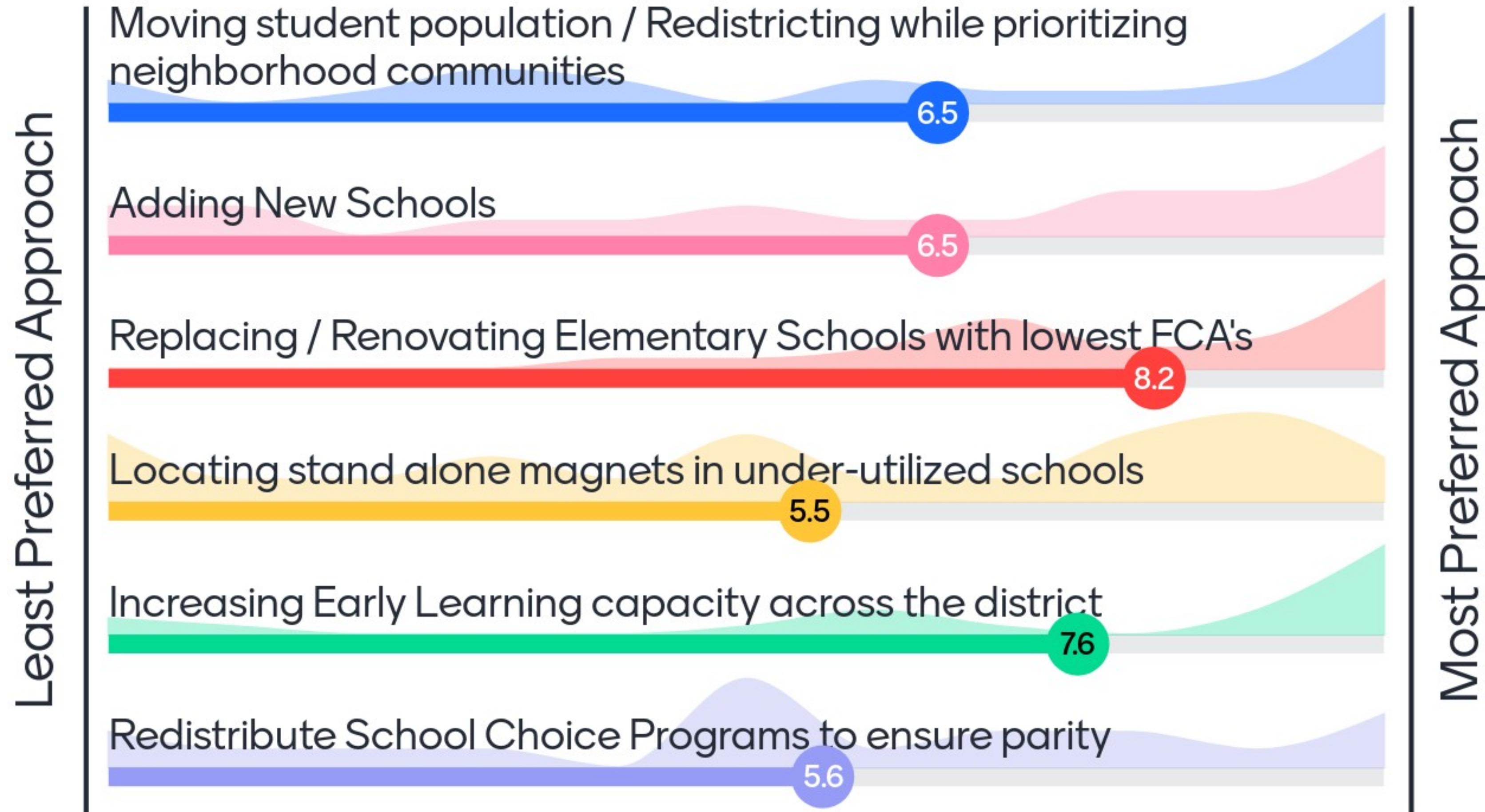


Please Rank the Strategies Below

Kids looking forward to school. New schools have been built where they didn't need to be built there

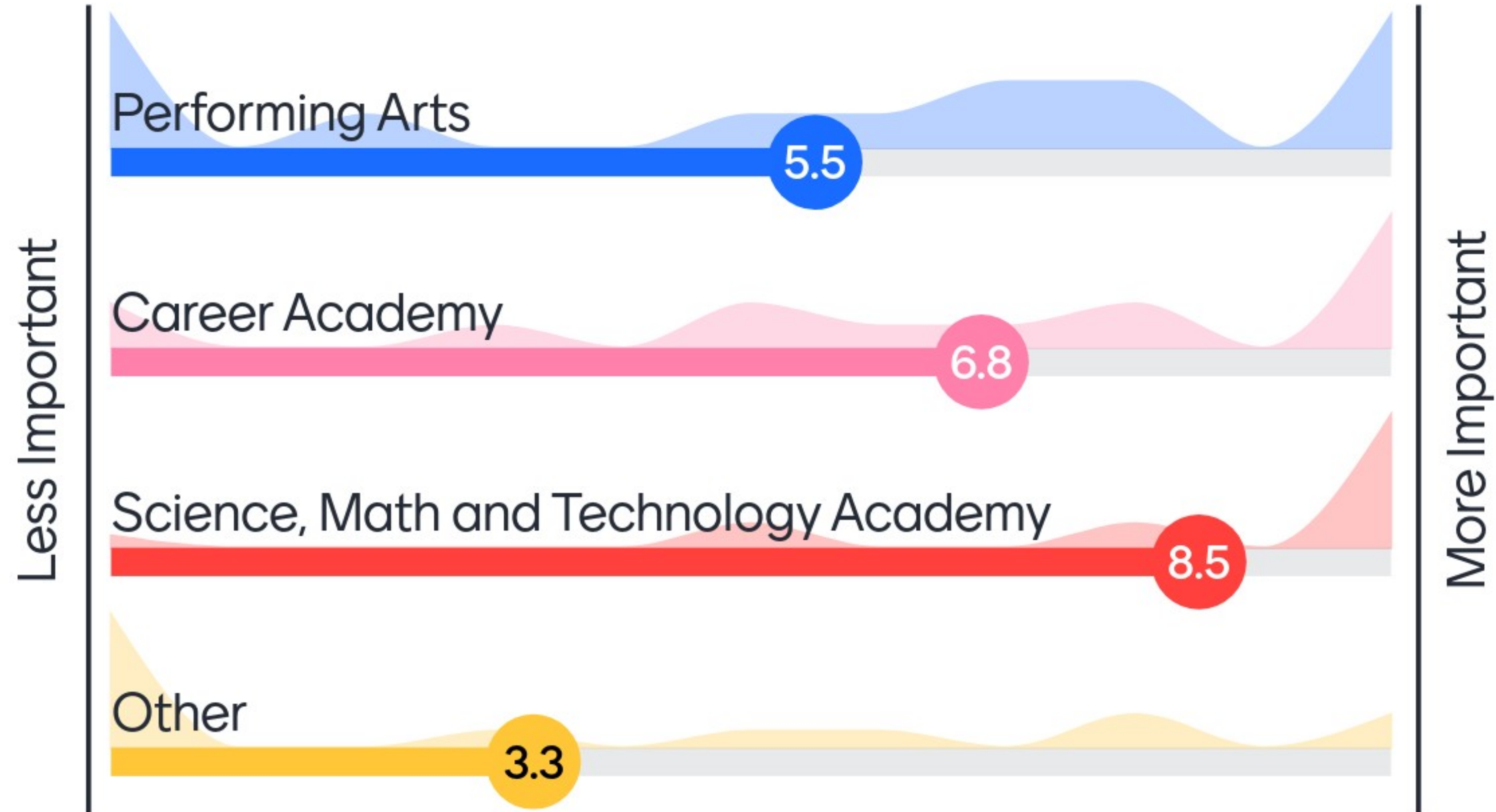
Our high school is at 154% capacity. If redistricting occurs, our community will benefit from a right-sized school. Morale will get a boost.

My children will be able to safely learn in a building that can hold them. I would love for my kids to have access to similar teacher-to-student ratios as in other parts of the county.

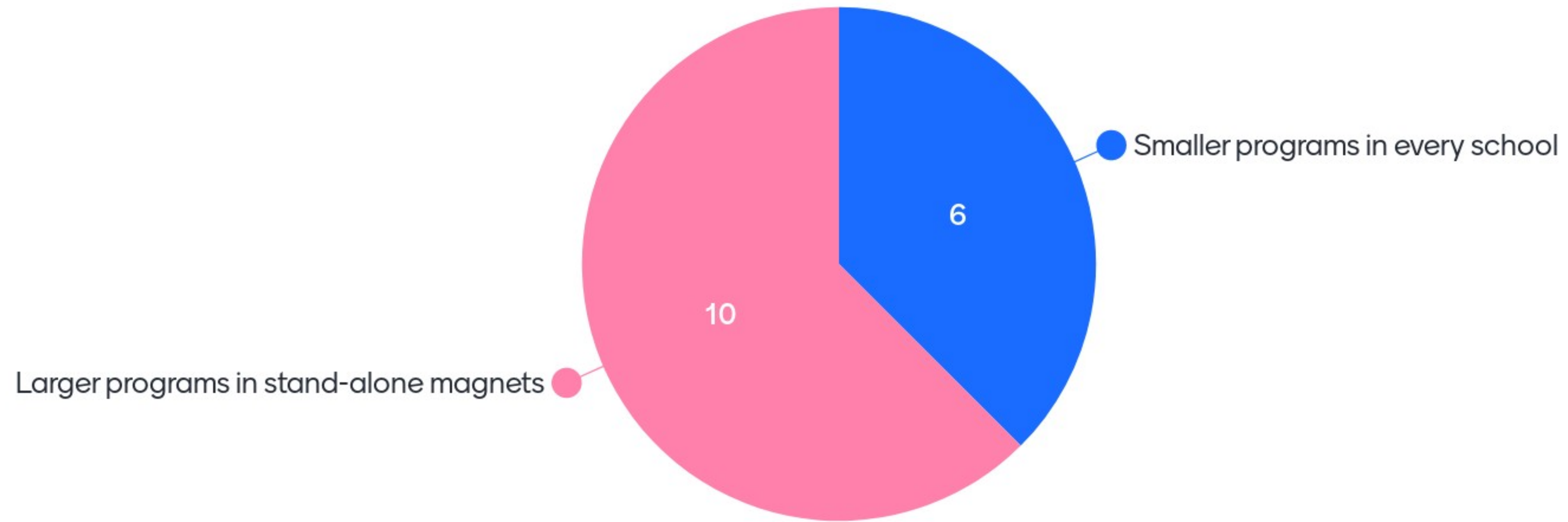
improving diversity to better reflect the neighborhoods around the the schools instead of "gerry mandering" to keep all the kids in apartments and Hispanic families in the same school.
