## NOTICE OF PROPERTY TAX INCREASE

The <u>DeKalb County School District</u> has tentatively adopted a millage rate which will require an increase in property taxes by <u>14.31</u> percent.

This tentative increase will result in a millage rate of <u>23.08 mills</u>, an increase of <u>2.889 mills</u>. Without this tentative tax increase, the millage rate will be no more than <u>20.191 mills</u>. The proposed tax increase for a home with a fair market value of <u>\$300,000</u> is approximately <u>\$361.13</u> and the proposed tax increase for non-homestead property with a fair market value of <u>\$500,000</u> is approximately <u>\$577.80</u>.
