WHY REDISTRICTING?

- Substantial overcrowding in the Cross Keys Cluster
- The goal is to reduce portable classrooms for next school year
- Instead of using 3rd and 4th grade academies for Fall 2016 relief, redistrict K-5 schools
- Utilize any available nearby excess capacity:
 - Fernbank ES, vacant Former ISC Facility, and Chamblee HS for Fall 2016
 - Possible re-use of Warren Tech for Fall 2017



OTHER CROSS KEYS CLUSTER INITIATIVES

- Tonight's meeting is focused on redistricting for next school year, Fall 2016*
- Status of long-term options for Cross Keys Cluster:
 - Currently conducting land search for two new 900 seat elementary schools
 - Capacity additions (or other recommendations) for Cross Keys HS and Sequoyah MS will be reviewed as part of the Secondary School Facility Planning and Feasibility Study that will initiate in March 2016 with public meetings

* Fall of 2017 for Warren Tech facility

REDISTRICTING CRITERIA

 Board Policy AD: Alteration of School Attendance Areas defines primary and secondary criteria

Primary Criteria, based on logistics
Geographic proximity
Instructional capacity
Projected enrollment

Note: Students may not always be assigned to their closest school, since other criteria must also be considered.

REDISTRICTING CRITERIA

- Secondary Criteria, when the primary criteria indicate more than one option for action
 - Safety and traffic patterns
 - Previous redistricting
 - Balancing of special programs, (i.e., ESOL, programs serving special needs students that require additional classroom space, etc.)
 - School feeder alignment
 - Intact neighborhoods



REDISTRICTING PROCESS

Round 1 community meeting

- Everyone participates equally
- Meeting starts with this presentation
- Divide into small-group break-out sessions
- Small-groups facilitated by trained staff
- Equity in the process
- Focused discussion on the criteria




REDISTRICTING PROCESS


- All options presented would go into effect in August 2016 with the exception of the Warren Tech portion of Elementary Option #2 that would go in effect August 2017
- Students rising into 5th, 11th, and 12th grades will have the option to continue in their former school, with no transportation provided









 elementary school





ES OPTION #2 (2016)


- D. Redistrict 101

- E. 292 Dresden ES students to Former ISC
- New K-5 school at Former ISC with 393 students




ES OPTION #2 (2017)

- F. (2017) Redistrict 383 Cary Reynolds ES students to former Warren Tech as new K-5 school
- Move Warren Tech program to vacant Terry Mill facility

Note: Cary Reynolds ES will need to wait for relief until the 2017-18 school year.



*ES Option #2 requires two years to implement: Fall 2016 and Fall 2017

- Redistrict 164 Cross Keys HS students to Chamblee HS
- These are the closest students to Chamblee HS
- First middle and high school split feeder in DeKalb County.



- Redistrict 180 Cross Keys HS students to Chamblee HS
- These are the students furthest away from Cross Keys HS.
- First middle and high school split feeder in DeKalb County
