German Dual-Language Immersion

In 2021-2022 the District will continue the Ashford Park dual language immersion articulation by expanding the dual language immersion program at Chamblee Middle School to include grades 6-8.

The district implements a 50/50 immersion model in the elementary school. Students are taught math, science, and German literacy in German. Using English, the students study literacy and receive more math support. In the middle school, students study Advanced Language and Literacy and World Studies.

The immersion program provides important benefits to students in the areas of cognition, achievement, and linguistics. Students will possess skills that create a professional competitive advantage, making them more attractive to colleges, career and technical programs, and employers.

Kindergarten students will be eligible to enroll in the dual-language immersion program. A limited number of first grade seats may be available. The students will be immersed in the German language and culture in elementary, middle, and high schools.

- Increase academic achievement in all areas
- Increase achievement in reading and mathematics significantly
- Instill cultural competence
- Prepare students to be sensitive and skilled when working with others across cultures
