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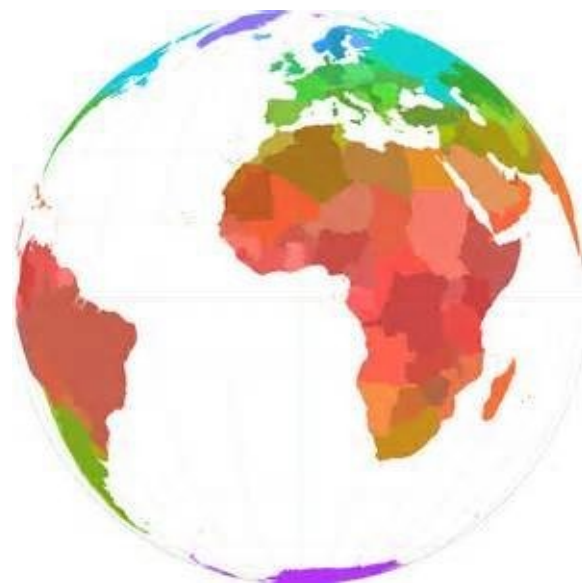

French Dual-Language Immersion

In 2021-2022 the District will continue the Rockbridge dual language immersion articulation by expanding the dual language immersion program at Stone Mountain Middle School to include grades 6-8.

The district implements a 50/50 immersion model. Students study math, science, and literacy in French. Using English, the students will study literacy, social studies and receive math support. In the middle school, students study Advanced Language and Literacy and World Studies.

The immersion program provides important benefits to students in the areas of cognition, achievement, and linguistics. Students will possess a skill that creates a professional competitive advantage, making them more attractive to colleges, career and technical programs, and employers.

Kindergarten students will be eligible to enroll in the dual-language immersion program. A limited number of first grade seats may be available. The students will be immersed in the French language and culture in elementary, middle, and high schools.

Goals of DSCD Immersion

- Improve literacy skills
- Increase academic achievement in all areas
- Increase achievement in reading and mathematics
- Instill cultural competence
- Prepare students to be sensitive and skilled when working with others across cultures
- Prepare students to be collaborators
- Prepare students to enter the global workforce

- Make a six year commitment to the program (grade K-12)
- Participate in educational activities which will support the educational program
- Provide a home environment that reinforces the goals of the program
