

The Programme works with Inquiry-Based thematic units, created by teachers, to encompass the Global context and cover all subject content areas: Language and Literature, Language Acquisition (French or Spanish), Individuals and Societies (Social Studies), Mathematics, Sciences, Physical and Health Education, Technology, and the Arts. IB Objectives are aligned to Georgia Standards of Excellence and Performance Standards,; throughout the grade levels unit planning, formative assessments, summative assessments, and reflection strengthen the core of the units.

In addition to IB requirements, Salem also offers all year French and Spanish for .5 high school credit (Carnegie Unit 7th & 8th), All year Visual and Fine Arts..
