



The Federal Programs office will be submitting an Educational Flexibility Program (ED-FLEX) Waiver to the Georgia Department of Education (GaDOE) to request approval to continue serving the following schools as Title I:

Schools	Poverty Percentages
Chamblee Charter High School	26.33%
Chestnut Elementary School	30.57%
Druid Hills High School	24.70%
Druid Hills Middle School	34.11%
Elizabeth Andrews High School	25.66%
Lakeside High School	25.30%
Livsey Elementary School	30.68%
Peachtree Middle School	28.68%

The above referenced schools have fallen below the 40% poverty threshold needed to be eligible to receive Title I funds.

The ED-FLEX waiver will allow said schools to receive an allocation for FY23 to continue school improvement efforts that support additional staffing, student and teacher resources, and professional learning. If approved, this waiver is valid for one year and requires individual school progress monitoring.
