GAME FORMAT


- Each school will participate in 4 rounds.



- Using a DCSD device, open Chrome and go to the competition day schedule at (link).
- Add a new tab for each of the following links:
 Questions, Challenge Room, Scoring Room and
 Scoring Form. (Note: Four tabs should be open in your browser)
- Make sure that you have the questions for the correct level (elementary, middle, or high school).
- Wait until everyone is in the room and seated to begin the round. (Volunteers, Coaches and team members)
- Welcome both teams to Round _____ of the Helen Ruffin Reading Bowl.**
- Introduce the moderator, console judge, timekeeper and scorekeeper.

Reminder: Each room needs 1 DCSD Laptop/ Device

Using a DCSD device, open Google Chrome Browser and Open a new tab for each of the following links (see Moderator email):

- 2) Challenge Room,
- 3) Scoring Room, and
- 4) Scoring Form.




- Remind everyone to turn off cell phones or set ringer to vibrate. Instruct volunteers and active participants that they should refrain from eating and drinking during each round.
- Read the competition rules in Round One and, if needed, repeat in subsequent rounds.
- Ask the console judge to check equipment in each round.
- Ask if there are any questions from the team members, or coaches.
- Announce the beginning of each round like "We are ready to begin Round _____.
- Announce the completion of the round
- If the round ends in a tie, do not ask a tie-breaker question. If needed, there will be a tie-breaker round at the end of the competition.

SCOREKEEPER



- Record the names of each school at the top of score paper and on the official Helen Ruffin Reading Bowl Coach's Score Verification Form.
- Keep scores on score paper. 10 points for correct answer; 0 points for no answer
- Tally and record total score at end of each round on official Helen Ruffin Reading Bowl coach's score verification form and have each coach sign at the bottom.
- Submit scores electronically on HRRB Electronic Score Form to the Scoring room.
- Open your door to signal the runner to pick up both your signed coach's score verification form and the large score sheet. Staple them together.
- Wait outside the door until signal to switch. Open the door and allow everyone to leave the room.

Submit

- Operate console for Quiz Pro/ Quizmatic.
- Test the buzzers at the beginning of each round.
- Call "Stop" if a player buzzes in before moderator completely reads a question.
- Call "We have a challenge" if a player raises their hand.
- Identify team and number of player who buzzes in first.
- Use stopwatch or phone to begin a count of 10 seconds as soon as team member is recognized.
- Use stopwatch or phone to begin time after each question is asked if no one buzzes in.
- Call time at the end of 10 seconds if no one buzzes in.
- Call time at the end of 10 seconds if no answer is given.
- Prepare Quiz Pro for next question by pressing the reset button. Signal moderator when ready for the next question.

CONSOLE JUDGE/ TIME KEEPER



GAME RULES

How To

- ✓ Students may hold the buzzer.
- ✓ When the student buzzes in, the console judge must acknowledge the student and team.
- ✓ The student who buzzed in must give the answer within 10 seconds. Conferring is NOT allowed.
- ✓ If the answer is incorrect, the question will be repeated for the other team. They will have 10 seconds to answer after buzzing in.
- ✓ If neither team buzzes in, the moderator will answer the question and proceed to the next question.
- ✓ If a contestant buzzes in before the completion of a question, the moderator stops reading and, after being recognized, the contestant must answer immediately. If an incorrect answer is given, the moderator reads the entire question and the opposing team has an opportunity to answer the question within 10 seconds.
- ✓ Any concern about an answer to a question MUST be addressed by the student to the COACHES before the next question is asked. The student will get the attention of the coach by raising their hand. Every effort will be made to reconcile any challenges.
- √ The moderator's decision is final.
- ✓ Coaches stay with your team. Your team may need you during the round if they have a challenge. Questions will be addressed before the round begins or after the round ends.
- ✓ If a round ends in a tie, there will not be a tie breaker question.

Don't Forget, let's keep a calm and controlled environment



*after reading the Rules, the Moderator will add:

"I'd like to remind all present that talking during the competition is inappropriate. Each team in violation, including team members, coaches, and visitors, consider this your one and only warning. If a violation occurs, the opposing team will receive ten points for the question being asked or answered when the violation occurs."

- The first and second place teams will represent DeKalb at the Metro Region Bowl on 2-10-2024.


