- Meet all requirements laid out in the applications

- 9th graders take one (1)
 Advanced Placement course and accelerated courses in other subjects
 (AP Government)
- 10th graders take at least two (2) Advanced Placement courses (AP World History and AP Econ or AP Psychology)
- Students are guaranteed a seat in the IB Diploma Programme beginning in 11th grade
