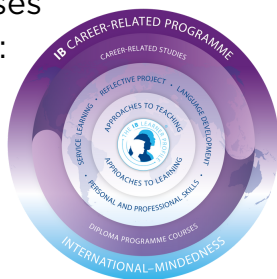
Benefits of Being an IB Student

THS IB Preparatory Programme (9th & 10th Grade)

- Minimum core of 3.0 average 8th grade
- Completing of Advanced/Accelerated/Gifted core curriculum in 7th & 8th grade
- Two favorable teacher recommendations from 7th & 8th grade core subject teachers
- Completing the School Choice & IB Application

IB Diploma Programme (11th & 12th Grade)

- Minimum core of 3.0 average at the end of 1st semester 10th grade
- Completing of Advanced/Accelerated/Gifted core curriculum in 9th & 10th grade
- Completed 2 years of a language
- Two favorable teacher recommendations from 9th & 10th grade core subject teachers
- Completing the School Choice & IB Application

IB Faculty Support

IB teachers have their own department and work together to not only provide integrated curriculum, but to ensure student growth.
